Important Registration Info

- There will be 50% refund for cancellations before April 15th.
- After May 15th, there will be no refunds as teachers are contracted for the classes and supplies have been ordered.

Frequently Asked Questions

What time does camp start?

Camp starts at 9:00 am each day and ends at noon.

Does Blessed Sacrament School offer additional care before and after classes, and how much does it cost?

Yes, AM Care runs from 8:00 am -9:00 am and costs \$15 for the week. Afternoon care runs from 12:00 pm to 4:00 pm and costs \$50 for the week. You must pre-register so that we can staff accordingly.

What if my child wants to join a camp, but is not in the proper grade level?

Call or email us! We will discuss with you the specific camp and can make an adjustment if necessary! We are happy to work with you to make your Knight happy!

Does Knights of Summer provide lunch on-campus?

Thursdays: LEGOS Thursday-Students will be divided into two age groups:

Little Knights of Summer LEGOS Day Camp-Challenge your scientific mind. Build and design contraptions with a day filled with engineering tasks, magnetic tiles, and building blocks! Throughout the day our Little Knight Engineers will use 21st-century skills of critical thinking, collaboration, problemsolving, adaptability, curiosity, and imagination.

Knights and Junior Knights of Summer LEGOS Day Camp-Challenge your scientific mind. Build and design contraptions with engineering tasks and Legos. From bungee jumping eggs to polishing pennies, have an STEM day as an engineer. Throughout the day our Junior Engineers will use 21st-century skills of critical thinking, collaboration, problem-solving, adaptability, curiosity, and imagination. Campers will modify and creatively build hands-on Lego projects that integrate science, technology, engineering, and math.



Fridays: Dino Friday-Students will be divided into two age groups.
