Rules of Participation and Play

- Players must be made up of middle school-age students (6th, 7th, 8th grade).
- Players must compete for the school they attend. Homeschool students are allowed to compete on a team (in whose district that they live) by approval from Randy Scott or Jag Gowda.
- Each match will consist of 6 singles matches and 3 doubles matches. Coaches will do their best to ensure all players participate in at least one match.
- The player's ability should organize each team's line-up. Stronger players should play at the top of the line-up with less experienced players at the bottom.
- Each single and doubles match will consist of one, 6-game set, no ad scoring, with a 7-point tiebreaker (win by 1) at 5-5. Coaches may agree to modify scoring if weather becomes an issue.
- Each team is awarded one point for a singles or doubles win. Five points are required to win the match. Matches will be played to completion.
- Coaches can go on the court to help with the rules and keep score at any time. Coaches from each team should help players on opposite teams when needed.

Emphasis should be placed on SPORTSMANSHIP AND FUN!

- Official roster and waiver of responsibility must be completed by each player and turned into their designated coach by the first week of the season. These forms should be turned in to the Burlington Tennis Center or Olde Forest Racquet Club at the end of the season. Additional players can be added during the season as long as paperwork is filled out.
- Players can only play singles or doubles unless a team has fewer than 12 players. In that case, the lowest seeded players on a team's roster will fill in to play as the number three, doubles teams.
- Coaches should email a completed scorecard at the conclusion of each match to the AJTF email account (tennis@ajtfnc.com).
