Frequently Asked Questions

What time does camp start?

Camp starts at 9:00 am each day and ends at noon.

Does Blessed Sacrament School offer additional care before and after classes, and how much does it cost?

Yes, AM Care runs from 7:30 am – 9:00 am and costs \$20 for the week. Afternoon care runs from 12:00 pm to 4:30 pm and costs \$50 for the week. You must pre-register so that we can staff accordingly.

What if my child wants to join a camp, but is not in the proper grade level?

Call or email us! We will discuss with you the specific camp and can make an adjustment if necessary! We are happy to work with you to make your Knight happy!

Does Knights of Summer provide lunch on-campus?

No. We ask that all campers bring their own lunch and drink. We do provide a microwave for those who may need it.

Can I sign up for a full day camps?

Yes. You have the option to sign up for camps from 9-12 and before/after camp care. Camps are priced accordingly, please look at our registration form.
