PALM SUNDAY

In the Gospel for Palm Sunday, we hear and participate in the story of Jesus' betrayal, arrest, trial and death on the Cross. In the liturgy, as members of the community read various parts in the Passion narrative, we are reminded that Jesus' Passion is ongoing today in the suffering of people around the world. Through our sins, we all contribute to this suffering - we can identify with Peter, the denier; Judas, the betrayer; Pilate, who turned his attention away; and the frantic crowd.

We also recall that in our experience of suffering we are connected to Christ. Jesus, God himself, was debased and mocked in the hands of prison guards. His dignity as a person - and, in an incomprehensible way, as God - was denied but not diminished. In the image of Christ on the cross we are reminded of the great dignity of all human life and especially those who suffer and are persecuted.

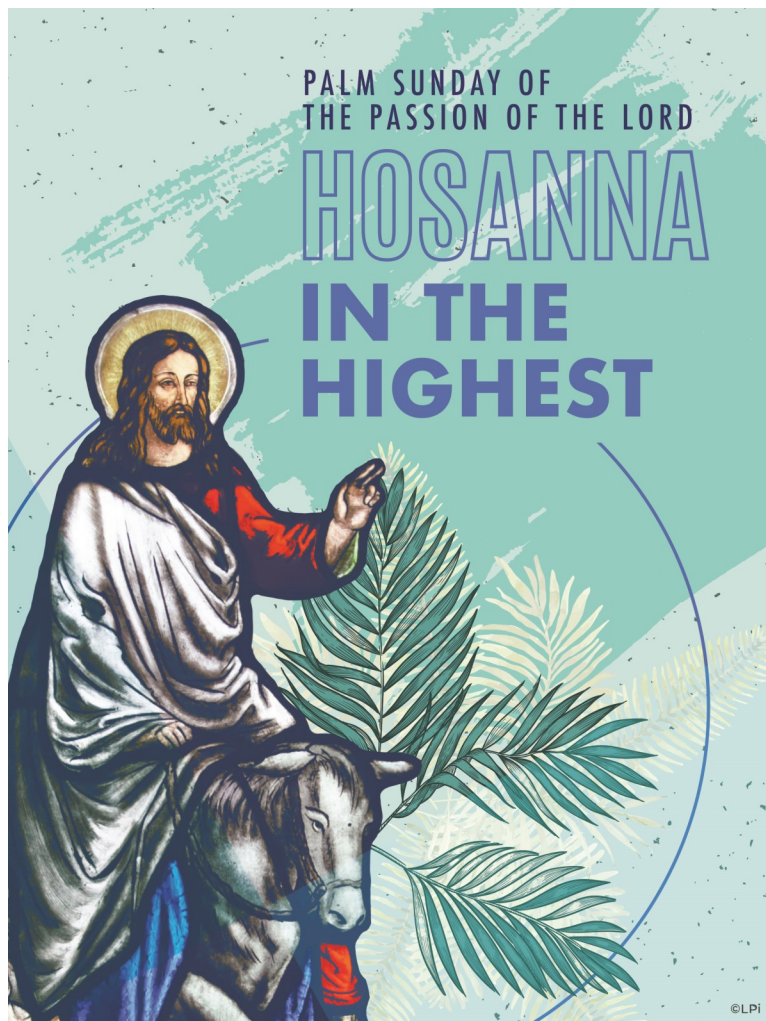
DOMINGO DE RAMOS

También recordamos que en nuestra experiencia de sufrimiento estamos conectados con Cristo. Jesús, Dios mismo, fue degradado y burlado en manos de los guardias de la prisión. Su dignidad como persona - y, de manera incomprendible, como Dios - fue negada pero no disminuida. A

imagen de Cristo en la cruz se nos recuerda la gran dignidad de toda vida humana y especialmente de los que sufren y son perseguidos.

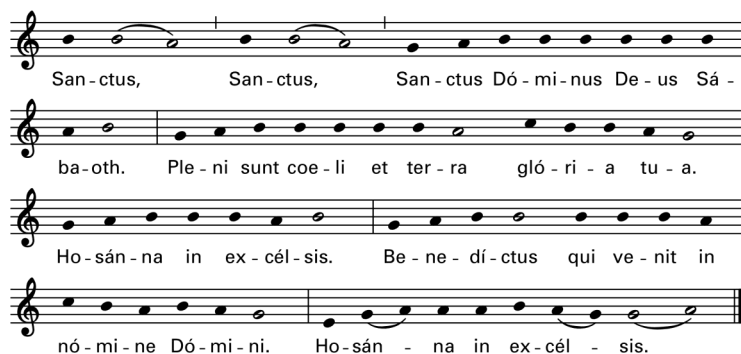
Second Reading | A reading from the letter of St. Paul to the Philippians (2:6-11)

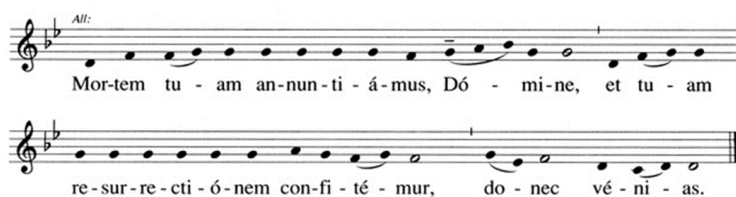

We are seeking nominations for upcoming elections for the Parish Pastoral Council and St. Francis School Board. All nominations

are to be emailed to Karen Mroz (k.mroz@dbqarch.org) by Sunday, April 24. Those who qualify to serve on the Pastoral Council: "registered parishioners who are baptized, confirmed, and practicing Catholic are eligible for election to the council, as well as for voting in the elections, unless they are impeded by Church law from holding office."

The purpose of the Pastoral Council is:

- * To *facilitate* a process by which the mission of the parish is determined and to serve as stewards of that mission.
- * To *implement the mission* by engaging in pastoral planning, which includes assessing parish needs, identifying resources, and determining priorities.
- * To *collaborate* with the finance council to maintain appropriate stewardship in implementing the mission of the parish.

The purpose of the School Board is:

- * The parish Catholic school board shall be responsible for all aspects of the Catholic School in light of the six tasks of catechesis. These include: Knowledge of Faith, Liturgy and Sacraments, Moral Formation in Jesus Christ, Prayer, Participate Actively in the Life and Mission of the Church, and Missionary Spirit.
- * To ensure the Catholic identity of the Catholic school.
- * To oversee and evaluate the program for consistency with mission of St. Francis Catholic school.
