## GOSPEL REFLECTION

Today we begin Holy Week, the days during which we journey with Jesus on his way of the cross and anticipate his Resurrection on Easter. Today's liturgy begins with the procession with palms to remind us of Jesus' triumphant entrance into Jerusalem. We will participate in the story of Jesus' Passion and death in Matthew's Gospel, which focuses on the obedience of Jesus to the will of his Father, even unto death.

In the characters of Matthew's account of the Passion, we find reflections of ourselves and the many ways in which we sometimes respond to Jesus. Sometimes we're like Judas, who betrays Jesus and comes to regret it; at other times, like Peter, who denies him, or like the disciples, who fell asleep during Jesus' darkest hour but then act rashly and violently at his arrest. Sometimes we are like Simon, who is pressed into service to help Jesus carry his cross, and sometimes we're like the leaders who fear Jesus or like Pontius Pilate, who washed his hands of the whole affair. But Jesus dies for all of us, out of love so that our sins will be forgiven.

During these days of Holy Week, let us meditate on these events and on the forgiveness that Jesus' obedience won for us.

## REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Hoy comenzamos la Semana Santa, los días durante los cuales caminamos con Jesús en su vía crucis y anticipamos su resurrección en Pascua. La liturgia de hoy comienza con la procesión con palmas para recordarnos la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén. Participaremos en la historia de la pasión y muerte de Jesús en el Evangelio de Mateo, que se centra en la obediencia de Jesús a la voluntad de su Padre, incluso hasta la muerte.

En los personajes del relato de Mateo sobre la Pasión, encontramos reflejos de nosotros mismos y de las muchas formas en que a veces respondemos a Jesús. A veces somos como Judas, que traiciona a Jesús y llega a arrepentirse; otras veces, como Pedro, que lo niega, o como los discípulos, que se durmieron durante la hora más oscura de Jesús, pero luego actúan precipitada y violentamente en su arresto. A veces somos como Simón, que es presionado al servicio para ayudar a Jesús a cargar su cruz, y a veces somos como los líderes que temen a Jesús o como Poncio Pilato, que se lavó las manos de todo el asunto. Pero Jesús muere por todos nosotros, por amor para que nuestros pecados sean perdonados.

Durante estos días de Semana Santa, meditemos sobre estos acontecimientos y sobre el perdón que la obediencia de Jesús nos ha valido.

**Gospel** | A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew (2:1-11)

When Jesus and the disciples drew near Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find an ass tethered, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them here to me. And if anyone should say anything to you, reply, 'The master has need of them.' Then he will send them at once." This happened so that what had been spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled: *Say to daughter Zion, "Behold, your king comes to you, meek and riding on an ass, and on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden."* The disciples went and did as Jesus had ordered them. They brought the ass and the colt and laid their cloaks over them, and he sat upon them. The very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and strewed them on the road. The crowds preceding him and those following kept crying out and saying: "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest." And when he entered Jerusalem the whole city was shaken and asked, "Who is this?" And the crowds replied, "This is Jesus the prophet, from Nazareth in Galilee." The gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, Lord, Jesus Christ.**

The Lord GOD has given me a well-trained tongue, that I might know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them. Morning after morning he opens my ear that I may hear; and I have not rebelled, have not turned back. I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard; my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting. The Lord GOD is my help, therefore I am not disgraced; I have set my face like flint, knowing that I shall not be put to shame. The word of the Lord. **Thanks be to God.**

**Evangelio** | Del santo Evangelio según Mateo (2, 1-11)

Cuando se aproximaban ya a Jerusalén, al llegar a Betfagé, junto al monte de los Olivos, envió Jesús a dos de sus discípulos, diciéndoles: "Vayan al pueblo que ven allí enfrente; al entrar, encontrarán amarrada una burra y un burrito con ella; desátenlos y tráiganmelos. Si alguien les pregunta algo, díganle que el Señor los necesita y enseguida los devolverá". Esto sucedió para que se cumplieran las palabras del profeta: *Díganle a la hija de Sión: He aquí que tu rey viene a ti, apacible y montado en un burro, en un burrito, hijo de animal de yugo.* Fueron, pues, los discípulos e hicieron lo que Jesús les había encargado y trajeron consigo la burra y el burrito. Luego pusieron sobre ellos sus mantos y Jesús se sentó encima. La gente, muy numerosa, extendía sus mantos por el camino; algunos cortaban ramas de los árboles y las tendían a su paso. Los que iban delante de él y los que lo seguían gritaban: "¡Hosanna! ¡Viva el Hijo de David! ¡Bendito el que viene en nombre del Señor! ¡Hosanna en el cielo!" Al entrar Jesús en Jerusalén, toda la ciudad se conmovió. Unos decían: "¿Quién es éste?" Y la gente respondía: "Éste es el profeta Jesús, de Nazaret de Galilea". Palabra del Señor. **Gloria a ti, Señor Jesus.**

**Primera lectura** | Lectura del libro del profeta Isaías (50, 4-7 )

En aquel entonces, dijo Isaías: "El Señor me ha dado una lengua experta, para que pueda confortar al abatido con palabras de aliento. Mañana tras mañana, el Señor despierta mi oído, para que escuche yo, como discípulo. El Señor Dios me ha hecho oír sus palabras y yo no he opuesto resistencia ni me he echado para atrás. Ofrecí la espalda a los que me golpeaban, la mejilla a los que me tiraban de la barba. No aparté mi rostro de los insultos y salivazos. Pero el Señor me ayuda, por eso no quedaré confundido, por eso endurecí mi rostro como roca y sé que no quedaré avergonzado". Palabra de Dios. **Te alabamos, Señor.**


