## GOSPEL REFLECTION

Between 1931 and 1938, Jesus appeared in Poland to Sister Faustina Kowalski, revealing to her that he wanted her to tell the whole world how much he wanted to show mercy to sinners. Jesus asked that the Sunday after Easter be celebrated as "Divine Mercy Sunday", and on April 30, 2000, St. John Paul II declared that it be so.

Today we hear of Thomas' story. He surely needed divine mercy! After all that had happened, he, like so many others, couldn't bring himself to believe any more and he was heartbroken. And because he wasn't there when Jesus appeared to the others and didn't see him with his own eyes, he refused to believe.

Maybe Thomas couldn't believe what the others told him, because they still weren't quite 100% convinced themselves! (After all, they were still in hiding!) Are we convinced of God's incredible love for us that others would believe us?

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, we are reminded that Jesus died on the cross so we could all find forgiveness. We only need to reach out to touch the wounds of our Risen Lord and we will experience his infinite mercy.



## REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO



In this you rejoice, although now for a little while you may have to suffer through various trials, so that the genuineness of your faith, more precious than gold that is perishable even though tested by fire, may prove to be for praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. Although you have not seen him you love him; even though you do not see him now yet believe in him, you rejoice with an indescribable and glorious joy, as you attain the goal of your faith, the salvation of your souls. ## **Gospel |** A reading from the holy Gospel according to John (20:19-31)

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nailmarks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Now, Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name. The gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, Lord, Jesus Christ.**





