
## GOSPEL REFLECTION

**"By his wounds you have been healed. For you had gone astray like sheep, but you have now returned to the shepherd and guardian of your souls." (1 Peter 2,25)**

The shepherd truly cares for every single one of his flock. Each sheep is counted every evening as they enter the fold, but sometimes the shepherd doesn't bother, for he can feel the absence of any one of his sheep. With one sheep gone, something is felt to be missing from the appearance of the entire flock.

One shepherd in the Lebanon district who does not count his sheep every evening said, "If you were to put a cloth over my eyes, and bring me any sheep and only let me put hands on its face, I could tell in a moment if it was mine or not."

But no shepherd has ever had a more intimate knowledge of his sheep than JESÚS, who truly knows those who belong to His flock. He once said of Himself, "I am the good shepherd and I know my sheep."



## REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

**"Por sus llagas ustedes han sido curados, porque ustedes eran como ovejas descarriadas, pero ahora han vuelto al pastor y guardián de sus vidas." (1 Ped. 2,25)**

El pastor realmente cuida de cada oveja de su rebaño. Cada oveja se cuenta cada noche cuando entran en el redil, pero a veces el pastor no lo hace, porque puede sentir la ausencia de cualquiera de sus ovejas. Con una oveja menos, se siente que algo falta en la apariencia de todo el rebaño.

Un pastor en el distrito del Líbano que no cuenta sus ovejas todas las noches dijo: "Si me taparas los ojos con un paño, y me trajeras cualquier oveja y solo me dejaras ponerle las manos en la cara, podría decir en un momento si era mía o no".

Pero ningún pastor ha tenido un conocimiento más íntimo de sus ovejas que JESÚS, que verdaderamente conoce a aquellos que pertenecen a su rebaño. Una vez dijo de sí mismo: "Yo soy el buen pastor y conozco a mis ovejas".

## Gospel | A reading from the holy Gospel according to John (10:1-10)

Jesus said: "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber. But whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him, and the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice. But they will not follow a stranger; they will run away from him, because they do not recognize the voice of strangers." Although Jesus used this figure of speech, the Pharisees did not realize what he was trying to tell them. So Jesus said again, "Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. A thief comes only to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly." The gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, Lord, Jesus Christ.**
