REFLECTING ON THE READINGS FATHER ALAN DIETZENBACH PASTOR

In today's Gospel, we hear Matthew list the names of the disciples before they are sent out (even before the Resurrection) to announce the Kingdom of God. A couple of years ago I learned a trick that helps me remember their names. Begin by using the word BAPTISM. From that word you can find the first letter of all their names. Here it goes:

B-Bartholome

A-Andrew

P-Peter and Philip

T-Thomas

I(J)-James (son of Zebedee), James (son of Alphaeus), Judas (Tadeo), John, Judas

S-Simon (the fanatic)

M-Matthew

What is curious is that the Gospel seems to give less importance to who they are than to how many they are. Often the Gospels simply refer to them as "the Twelve"; the reason is that they represent the New Israel. Just as Israel had 12 tribes (going back to Jacob's 12 sons), now the New Israel is not determined by lineage, but by the free choice of Jesus.

Although there are much more than 12 Catholics, we too have been freely chosen by Jesus for his mission. Do you really believe that Jesus has also chosen you for an extraordinary mission?

En el Evangelio de hoy, escuchamos a Mateo enumerar los nombres de los discípulos antes de que sean enviados (incluso antes de la Resurrección) para anunciar el Reino de Dios. Hace un par de años aprendí un truco que me ayuda a recordar sus nombres. Comienza usando la palabra BAUTISM (BAUTISMO). De esa palabra puedes encontrar la primera letra de todos sus nombres. Aquí va:

B-Bartolomé

A-Andrew

P-Pedro y Philip (Felipe)

T-Tomas


I(J)-Jaimes(Santiago) (hijo de Zebedeo), James (Santiago)(hijo de Alfeo), Judas (Tadeo), Juan, Judas

S-Simon (el fanático)

M-Mateo

Lo que es curioso es que el Evangelio parece dar menos importancia a quiénes son que a cuántos son. A menudo, los Evangelios simplemente se refieren a ellos como "los Doce"; la razón es que representan al Nuevo Israel. Así como Israel tenía 12 tribus (remontándose a los 12 hijos de Jacob), ahora el Nuevo Israel no está determinado por el linaje, sino por la libre elección de Jesús.

Aunque los católicos somos mucho más de 12, también nosotros hemos sido elegidos libremente por Jesús para su misión. ¿De verdad crees que Jesús también te ha elegido a ti para una misión extraordinaria?

Second Reading | A reading from the first letter of St. Paul to the Romans (5:6-11)

Brothers and sisters: Christ, while we were still helpless, yet died at the appointed time for the ungodly. Indeed, only with difficulty does one die for a just person, though perhaps for a good person one might even find courage to die. But God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us. How much more then, since we are now justified by his blood, will we be saved through him from the wrath. Indeed, if, while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, how much more, once reconciled, will we be saved by his life. Not only that, but we also boast of God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation. The word of the Lord. **Thanks be to God.**


Segunda lectura | Lectura de la primera carta del apóstol San Pablo a los Romanos (5, 6-11)

Gospel | A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew (9:36-10:8)

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever." The gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, Lord, Jesus Christ.**

Nicene Creed

Evangelio | Del santo Evangelio según san Mateo (9, 36-10, 8)

En aquel tiempo, al ver Jesús a las multitudes, se compadecía de ellas, porque estaban extenuadas y desamparadas, como ovejas sin pastor. Entonces dijo a sus discípulos: "La cosecha es mucha y los trabajadores, pocos. Rueguen, por lo tanto, al dueño de la mies que envíe trabajadores a sus campos". Después, llamando a sus doce discípulos, les dio poder para expulsar a los espíritus impuros y curar toda clase de enfermedades y dolencias. Éstos son los nombres de los doce apóstoles: el primero de todos, Simón, llamado Pedro, y su hermano Andrés; Santiago y su hermano Juan, hijos de Zebedeo; Felipe y Bartolomé; Tomás y Mateo, el publicano; Santiago, hijo de Alfeo, y Tadeo; Simón, el cananeo, y Judas Iscariote, que fue el traidor. A estos doce los envió Jesús con estas instrucciones: "No vayan a tierra de paganos ni entren en ciudades de samaritanos. Vayan más bien en busca de las ovejas perdidas de la casa de Israel. Vayan y proclamen por el camino que ya se acerca el Reino de los cielos. Curen a los leprosos y demás enfermos; resuciten a los muertos y echen fuera a los demonios. Gratuitamente han recibido este poder; ejérzanlo, pues, gratuitamente". Palabra del Señor.




