

GOSPEL REFLECTION

"Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."

Today's Gospel is about priority, what is our priority? Is my priority what I want, my needs, my feelings or is my priority Jesus and what God wants for me and my life? Is love-of-self number one or is love-of-God number one? Jesus asks us today to be our number one, to be our priority, to take up our cross and follow Him, whatever our cross may be today.

Jesus said, "whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me." Hard words. We are always called to love those in our lives, whether they are family, friends and even

enemies. We are to love, and we are to pray for those who persecute us. I think that the perspective is one of priority. Keep our eyes on Jesus as we love our son and daughters, mothers and fathers, even those who are Difficult to love. Jesus asks us to keep our eyes on Him; to be our first priority, to love as He loved. To take our eyes off of self and keep our eyes on Him.

Does the mother take up her daily "cross" as she gets up at night for a wakeful child? Does the grandfather put down his book to read to his grandchild? Does the teen take time to listen to his mom rather than always watching tiktok? This is taking up our cross, losing our life, loving Jesus first, taking our eyes off of ourselves.

One day Elisha came to Shunem, where there was a woman of influence, who urged him to dine with her. Afterward, whenever he passed by, he used to stop there to dine. If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him. We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him. As to his death, he died to sin once and for all; as to his life, he lives for God. Consequently, you too must think of yourselves as dead to sin and living for God in Christ Jesus. 





Hispanic Ministry Coordinator Position Changes

Sr. Christine Feagan, O.P arrived to St. Mary Parish in 1999 when the needs of the nascent Hispanic immigrant population were markedly different from their needs today. At that time, newly arrived immigrants needed immigration support, translation assistance and help setting up utilities for their homes. Over the past 25 years, the Catholic faithful and the greater Marshalltown have risen to help meet many of these needs. We are now living with a majority second and third generation populace who have made Marshalltown their home, and who are juggling the influence of two or more cultures. Currently, 60% of St. Francis of Assisi parishioners are Hispanic. We should no longer think of Hispanic Ministry as a subset of our parish community, but rather *parish ministry to Hispanics*, of which some are Spanish speaking.

We are ever grateful for the many years of ministry Sr. Chris has given in the service of Jesus' flock in Marshalltown. This change invites us to reimagine this role for the long-term advancement of the mission of Jesus and seeking greater unity within our parish community. To that end, the role of Director of Hispanic Ministry will shift to Fr. Alan as the pastor. A new role will be created in the place of Sr. Chris for a Spanish-speaking Pastoral Associate. This would somewhat mirror (but not duplicate) Karen Mroz's role as Pastoral Associate. This full-time role would include:

1. Volunteer Promotion & Training (ie. Liturgical trainings, service opportunities)
2. Adult Faith Formation (ie. baptism preparation, marriage preparation, family events, prayer group liaison)
3. Promoter of Cultural Traditions (ie. Our Lady of Guadalupe, Quinceañeras)
4. Advocacy/Assistance for Hispanics (ie. Form letters, and limited translation services)
5. Office Assistance to Priests.

I am happy to announce that our current parish secretary and bulletin editor, Hilda Santamaría will be moving into this Coordinator of Hispanic Ministry role! So, we will be hiring a new parish secretary. If interested, please email a resume to Fr. Alan. Changes will be difficult and take time to adjust, but we should not expect Hilda to be a new "Sr. Chris"!. No one can fill her shoes, her wisdom or the impact she has made! Thank you for your patience in this time of transition and please let Fr. Alan know if you have any concerns or suggestions.

Cambios en la posición del Coordinador del Ministerio Hispano

La Hna. Christine Feagan, O.P llegó a la Parroquia de St. Mary en 1999 cuando las necesidades de la población inmigrante hispana naciente eran marcadamente diferentes a las necesidades de hoy. En ese momento, los inmigrantes recién llegados necesitaban apoyo de inmigración, asistencia de traducción y ayuda para instalar servicios para sus hogares. Durante los últimos 25 años, los fieles católicos y el gran Marshalltown se han levantado para ayudar a satisfacer muchas de estas necesidades. Ahora vivimos con una población mayoritaria de segunda y tercera generación que han hecho de Marshalltown su hogar y que están haciendo malabarismos con la influencia de dos o más culturas. Actualmente, el 60% de los feligreses de St. Francis of Assisi son hispanos. Ya no debemos pensar en el Ministerio Hispano como un subconjunto de nuestra comunidad parroquial, sino en el ministerio parroquial para los hispanos, de los cuales algunos hablan español.

Estamos siempre agradecidos por los muchos años de ministerio. Hna. Chris ha dado al servicio del rebaño de Jesús en Marshalltown. Este cambio nos invita a reimaginar este papel para el avance a largo plazo de la misión de Jesús y buscar una mayor unidad dentro de nuestra comunidad parroquial. Con ese fin, el papel de Director del Ministerio Hispano pasará al P. Alan como el pastor. Se creará un nuevo rol en el lugar de la Hna. Chris para una Pastoral de habla hispana Asociado. Esto reflejaría (pero no duplicaría) el rol de Karen Mroz como Asociada Pastoral. Este rol de tiempo completo incluiría:

1. Promoción y capacitación de voluntarios (es decir, capacitaciones litúrgicas, oportunidades de servicio)
2. Formación de fe para adultos (es decir, preparación para el bautismo, preparación para el matrimonio, eventos familiares, grupo de oración enlace)
3. Promotor de tradiciones culturales (es decir, Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, Quinceañeras)
4. Abogacía/asistencia para hispanos (es decir, cartas modelo y servicios de traducción limitados)
5. Asistencia de oficina a los sacerdotes.

¡Estoy feliz de anunciar que nuestra actual secretaria parroquial y editora del boletín, Hilda Santamaría, asumirá este rol de Coordinadora del Ministerio Hispano! Por lo tanto, vamos a contratar a una nueva secretaria parroquial. Si está interesado, envíe un correo electrónico con un currículum al Fr. Alan. Los cambios serán difíciles y llevarán tiempo adaptarse, pero no debemos esperar que Hilda sea una nueva "Sr. Cris"!. ¡Nadie puede llenar sus zapatos, su sabiduría o el impacto que ha tenido! Gracias por su paciencia en este momento de transición y por favor dejele saber a el P. Alan si tiene alguna inquietud o sugerencia.
