GOSPEL REFLECTION

Fr. Alan Dietzenbach, Pastor

Whenever I drive from Marshalltown to Des Moines and pass through Bondurant, it hurts my heart. Maybe it's the "kid of a dairy farm family" in me, but seeing some of the most fertile land on the planet being developed into houses just isn't right. I find myself vexing between the Lorax and the wonderful Joni Mitchell: "they paved paradise and put up a parking lot." Part of me wants to scream, don't you know what you are building on? Don't you see the treasure beneath you?!? Ok, I'm getting down off my soapbox.

In our Gospel today, we hear about similar overlooked treasures: the treasure buried in a field, the pearl of great price there for anyone to find, and the fish beneath the surface just waiting to be caught. An ancient church father named Origin says that when we hear these "the Kingdom of Heaven is like..." parables we can substitute "Jesus" for "the Kingdom of God." As he says: "Jesus is the Kingdom of God in a person."

Do we overlook the treasure that is Jesus in our lives? Are we willing to give all to follow him or do we "pave paradise" to build our own parking lots? The treasure of Jesus is there if we are willing to look just below the surface.

REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Cada vez que conduzco de Marshalltown a Des Moines y paso por Bondurant, me duele el corazón. Tal vez sea el "niño de una familia de granjas lecheras" en mí, pero ver que algunas de las tierras más fértiles del planeta se están convirtiendo en casas simplemente no es correcto. Me encuentro molesto entre el Lorax y la maravillosa Joni Mitchell: "pavimentaron el paraíso y pusieron un estacionamiento". Una parte de mí quiere gritar, ¿no sabes en qué estás construyendo? ¿¿No ves el tesoro debajo de ti?? Ok, me estoy bajando de mi tribuna.



En nuestro Evangelio de hoy, escuchamos acerca de tesoros pasados por alto similares: el tesoro enterrado en un campo, la perla de gran precio allí para que cualquiera

la encuentre, y el pez debajo de la superficie que espera ser capturado. Un antiguo padre de la iglesia llamado Origen dice que cuando escuchamos estas parábolas "el Reino de los Cielos es como...", podemos sustituir "Jesús" por "el Reino de Dios". Como él dice: "Jesús es el Reino de Dios en una persona".

¿Pasamos por alto el tesoro que es Jesús en nuestras vidas? ¿Estamos dispuestos a darlo todo para seguirlo o "abrimos el paraíso" para construir nuestros propios estacionamientos? El tesoro de Jesús está allí si estamos dispuestos a mirar justo debajo de la superficie.

Primera lectura | Lectura del libro de la Reyes (3, 5-13)

En aquellos días, el Señor se le apareció al rey Salomón en sueños y le dijo: "Salomón, pídemelo lo que quieras, que yo te lo daré". What is bad they throw away. Thus it will be at the end of the age. The angels will go out and separate the wicked from the righteous and throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth. "Do you understand all these things?" They answered, "Yes." And he replied, "Then every scribe who has been instructed in the kingdom of heaven is like the head of a household who brings from his storeroom both the new and the old." The gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, Lord, Jesus Christ.**

Nicene Creed




