
## GOSPEL REFLECTION

## REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

"I urge you by the mercies of God to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, your spiritual worship." Romans 12:1 I don't like to sacrifice; I don't like to fast. I am not very good at it, I tell myself, so I rarely do it. I find it very hard to do. Don't eat meat on Fridays? Well, Friday comes along and I either forget, or I want meat on my pizza. Don't eat between meals? Ha, that just isn't going to happen. But what kind of sacrifice is God calling ME to do. My youngest daughter just gave birth to her 2nd child. Her pregnancy was uncomfortable and, well, 9 months is a long time. The first night home, little Henry didn't sleep until 4am. The next night, little Henry wanted to eat every 2 hours. SACRIFICE. She, as all mothers do, sacrificed sleep, for the sake of their newborn, or the 2 year old with the flu, or the 6 year old with nightmares. Mothers and Fathers offer their bodies as living sacrifices. What they give up for the sake of their children is a living sacrifice. And God loves a cheerful giver. Married couples are called to sacrifice for one another on a daily basis. The vacuum cleaner needs fixed right now, so he drops what he wants to do to fix it. There is a new movie out that she is not particularly interested in seeing, but she goes anyway. She just has knee surgery, so he has to drive her to doctors' appointments. There are so many ways we are called to stop focusing on ourselves for the other. Love is sacrifice for the other. "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." That is a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God.

Romanos 12:1 No me gusta sacrificarme; No me gusta ayunar. No soy muy bueno en eso, me digo, así que rara vez lo hago. Lo encontré muy difícil de hacer. ¿No comes carne los viernes? Bueno, llega el viernes yo me olvido o quiero carne en mi pizza. ¿No comer entre horas? Ja, eso simplemente no va a suceder. Pero ¿qué clase de El sacrificio es Dios llamándome a hacer. Mi hija menor acaba de dar a luz a su segundo hijo. Su embarazo fue incómodo y, bueno, 9 meses es mucho tiempo. La primera noche en casa, el pequeño Henry no durmió hasta las 4 de la mañana. La noche siguiente, pequeño Henry quería comer cada 2 horas. SACRIFICIO. Ella, como todas las madres, sacrificó el sueño por el bien de su recién nacido, o el niño de 2 años con gripe, o el niño de 6 años con pesadillas. Madres y padres ofrecer sus cuerpos como sacrificio vivo. Lo que renuncian por el bien de sus hijos es un sacrificio vivo. Y Dios ama al dador alegre. Las parejas casadas están llamadas a sacrificarse el uno por el otro diariamente. La aspiradora necesita ser reparada, ahora mismo, deja de lado lo que quiere hacer para solucionarlo. Hay una nueva película que ella no está particularmente interesada en ver, pero ella va de todos modos. Ella acaba de ser operada de la rodilla, por lo que él tiene que llevarla a las citas médicas. Hay tantas maneras en las que estamos llamados a dejar de centrarnos en nosotros mismos por el momento del otro. El amor es sacrificio por el otro. "Porque el que quiera salvar su vida, la perderá; pero el que pierda su vida por mí, la encontrará." Eso es sacrificio vivo, santo y agradable a Dios.



### Nicene Creed






### ARISE: A HOLY SPIRIT PRAYER MINISTRY

There was once a group studying Malachi 3:3 that says: "He will sit as a refiner and purifier of silver." This verse puzzled the group, and they wondered what this statement meant about the character and nature of God. One member offered to find out about the process of refining silver. The volunteer met with a silversmith to watch him at work. She didn't mention anything about the reason for her interest. As she watched, he held a piece of silver over the fire and let it heat up. He said that in refining silver, one needed to hold the silver in the middle of the fire where the hottest flames burnt away all impurities. The woman thought about God holding us in such a hot spot through the trials of life – then she thought again about the verse, that God sits as a refiner and purifier of silver. She asked the silversmith if it was true that he had to sit there in front of the fire the whole time the silver was being refined. The man answered "Yes" and explained that he not only had to sit there holding the silver, but he had to keep his eyes on the silver the entire time it was in the fire. If the silver was left even a moment too long in the flames, it would be ruined. The woman was silent for a moment. Then she asked the silversmith, "How do you know when the silver is fully refined?" He smiled at her and answered, "Oh, that's easy. When I see my image in it." (Aceaedo Homestead) If today you are feeling the heat of this world's fire, just remember that God has His eyes on you.
