YOU WANT ME TO GO WHERE, GOD?!?

FR. ALAN DIETZENBACH

I recently finished a phenomenal 5-hour study on the prophet Jonah by Protestant Pastor and founder of the Bible Project, Tim Mackie (available for free on YouTube). I couldn't recommend it enough. He explains that the prophet Jonah, not only symbolizes Israel as a nation but also all of us as individuals. In fact, Jonah (the great prophet of God, whose name means "Dove, Son of Faithfulness") is the most faithless person in the whole book!

When Jonah is asked to go to Nineveh, it's no surprise that he wants to head in the exact opposite direction. Nineveh was the largest empire of its time and well known for sieging smaller tribes and skinning them alive. How convenient that he is spit on the shore of Nineveh after being swallowed by the whale. He does the bare minimum preaching to them and then sets up camp, hoping to watch Nineveh's destruction. Unlike the Grinch, whose heart is moved when he sees his enemies' faith, Jonah is filled with hatred at God - even wishing he was dead!

Jonah reminds us that conversion is not a "answer the call" and we're good sort of thing. It requires a continued interior conversion that comes when we are confronted with a God that loves our enemies. Toward the end of the lecture Mackie offers a helpful exercise. He instructs: 1. think of an enemy you have, 2. write down all the traits/character flaws they have that drive you nuts, 3. Now write down any time when you did those same things! See, God is still calling you deeper...all the way to Nineveh!

¿DÓNDE QUIERES QUE VALLA A DIOS?!?

FR. ALAN DIETZENBACH

Recientemente terminé un fenomenal estudio de 5 horas sobre el profeta Jonás realizado por el pastor protestante y fundador del Proyecto Bíblico, Tim Mackie (disponible de forma gratuita en YouTube). No podría recomendarlo lo suficiente. Explica que el profeta Jonás no sólo simboliza a Israel como nación sino también a todos nosotros como individuos. De hecho, Jonás (el gran profeta de Dios, cuyo nombre significa "Paloma, Hijo de la Fidelidad") es la persona más infiel de todo el libro.



Cuando a Jonás le piden que vaya a Nínive, no sorprende que quiera ir exactamente en la dirección opuesta. Nínive era el imperio más grande de su época y era conocido por asediar a tribus más pequeñas y mantenerlas con vida. Qué conveniente que lo escupan en la orilla de Nínive después de haber sido tragado por la ballena. Les predica lo mínimo y luego instala un campamento, con la esperanza de presenciar la destrucción de Nínive. A diferencia del Grinch, cuyo corazón se commueve cuando ve la fe de sus enemigos en él, Jonah está lleno de odio hacia Dios, ¡incluso deseando estar muerto!

Jonás nos recuerda que la conversión no es "responder al llamado" y que somos algo bueno. Requiere una conversión interior continua que se produce cuando nos enfrentamos a un Dios que ama a nuestros enemigos. Hacia el final de la conferencia, Mackie ofrece un ejercicio útil. Él instruye: 1. piensa en un enemigo que tienes, 2. escribe todos los rasgos/defectos de carácter que tiene y que te vuelven loco, 3. ¡Ahora escribe cualquier momento en el que hiciste esas mismas cosas! Mira, Dios todavía te está llamando más profundamente... ¡hasta Nínive!

First Reading | A reading from the book of Prophet Jonah 3:1-5, 10

The word of the LORD came to Jonah, saying: "Set out for the great city of Nineveh, and announce to it the message that I will tell you." So Jonah made ready and went to Nineveh, according to the LORD'S bidding. Now Nineveh was an enormously large city; it took three days to go through it. Jonah began his journey through the city, and had gone but a single day's walk announcing, "Forty days more and Nineveh shall be destroyed," when the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast and all of them, great and small, put on sackcloth. When God saw by their actions how they turned from their evil way, he repented of the evil that he had threatened to do to them; he did not carry it out. **The word of the Lord. Thanks be to God.**
