
## GOSPEL REFLECTION

## REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

### A Precious Sacrifice

Fr. Kyle Tietz

What could God do to show us his love? We often demonstrate love through words and actions. At times, we offer precious gifts. And what is more precious than God's only Son, Jesus? In both the first reading and the second, we see Fathers freely handing over their Sons. Abraham offers his son Isaac, his "only one," the one whom he loves. God the Father sent us Jesus and "handed him over for us all." In both cases, these are grown sons, cooperative in their self-offering. Isaac is strong enough to carry the wood for the sacrifice, but freely allows his father to bind him to the altar. Jesus, too, carries the wood of the cross and allows himself to be bound by the nails. Ultimately, God shows us that he rejects human sacrifice. "Do not lay your hand on the boy!" cries the angel. "I know now how devoted you are to God, since you did not withhold from me your own beloved son." Unlike the pagan gods, the God of Israel is not sated by human blood. Yet in rejecting this type of sacrifice, God allows his Divine Son to freely offer his self-sacrifice for us. Only a Son, both divine and human, could bridge the divide between God and man. Only a sinless Son could conquer sin. And only the risen Son could defeat death once and for all. This self-sacrifice of Jesus, this painfully loving offering of God the Father, is the reason for our hope. As St. Paul declares: "If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son but handed him over for us all, how will he not also give us everything else along with him?"



### UN SACRIFICIO PRECIOSO

¿Qué podría hacer Dios para mostrarnos su amor por él? A menudo demostramos amor a través de palabras y acciones. A veces ofrecemos regalos preciosos. ¿Y qué es más precioso que el único Hijo de Dios, Jesús? Tanto en la primera lectura como en la segunda, vemos a los Padres manejando libremente a sus Hijos. Abraham ofrece a su hijo Isaac, el "único de él", aquel a quien ama. Dios Padre nos envió a Jesús y "lo entregó por todos nosotros". En ambos casos, se trata de hijos adultos, cooperativos en su ofrenda. Isaac es lo suficientemente fuerte como para cargar la leña para el sacrificio, pero permite libremente que su padre lo ate al altar. También Jesús lleva el madero de la cruz y se deja atar por los clavos. En última instancia, Dios nos muestra que rechaza el sacrificio humano. "¡No le pongas la mano encima al niño!" llora el ángel. "Ahora sé cuán devoto eres de Dios, ya que no me rehusaste a tu amado hijo". A diferencia de los dioses paganos, el Dios de Israel no se satisface con sangre humana. Sin embargo, al rechazar este tipo de sacrificio, Dios permite que su Divino Hijo ofrezca libremente su sacrificio por nosotros. Sólo un Hijo, tanto divino como humano, podría salvar la división entre Dios y el hombre. Sólo un Hijo sin pecado podría vencer el pecado. Y sólo el Hijo resucitado podría vencer a la muerte de una vez por todas. Este autosacrificio de Jesús, esta ofrenda dolorosamente amorosa de Dios Padre, es la razón de nuestra esperanza. Como declara San Pablo: "Si Dios es por nosotros, ¿quién podrá estar contra nosotros? El que no perdonó a su propio Hijo pero él lo entregó por todos nosotros, "¿Cómo no nos dará también todo lo demás junto con él?"

## First Reading | A reading from the book of Genesis 22:1-2-9, 10-13, 15-18

God put Abraham to the test. He called to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am!" he replied. Then God said: "Take your son Isaac, your only one, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah. There you shall offer him up as a holocaust on a height that I will point out to you." When they came to the place of which God had told him, Abraham built an altar there and arranged the wood on it. Then he reached out and took the knife to slaughter his son. But the LORD's messenger called to him from heaven, "Abraham, Abraham!" "Here I am!" he answered. "Do not lay your hand on the boy," said the messenger. "Do not do the least thing to him. I know now how devoted you are to God, since you did not withhold from me your own beloved son." As Abraham looked about, he spied a ram caught by its horns in the thicket. So he went and took the ram and offered it up as a holocaust in place of his son. Again the LORD's messenger called to Abraham from heaven and said: "I swear by myself, declares the LORD, that because you acted as you did in not withholding from me your beloved son, I will bless you abundantly and make your descendants as countless as the stars of the sky and the sands of the seashore; your descendants shall take possession of the gates of their enemies, and in your descendants all the nations of the earth shall find blessing—all this because you obeyed my command." **The word of the Lord. And he was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them. Then Elijah appeared to them along with Moses, and they were conversing with Jesus. Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Rabbi, it is good that we are here! Let us make three tents: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." He hardly knew what to say, they were so terrified. Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." Suddenly, looking around, they no longer saw anyone but Jesus alone with them. As they were coming down from the mountain, he charged them not to relate what they had seen to anyone, except when the Son of Man had risen from the dead. So they kept the matter to themselves, questioning what rising from the dead meant.
