Needs Assessment Summary of Analysis

Adults consider us above average. The only low items were technology and offering additional co-curricular and extra-curricular programs. However, co-curricular and extra-curricular programs were listed later as a low priority.

As a result, technology progress will continue. Adding co-curricular and extra-curricular programs will be tabled until other visions become realized first.

5/6th grade students consider us above average but rated the school much lower than parents. Biggest concern was the need for more academic rigor. There were a couple surprisingly low items: lack of Catholic symbols in school and failure to serve the poor. Also of concern was student's priority for academics is much lower than in other Archdiocese schools.

As a result:

- 1.) teachers will be informed about rigor and Dr. Herrick will utilize observations to push teachers to push students more.
- 2.) Careful consideration will go into inclusion of Catholic Symbols in the new school. (There are quite a few already. We half suspect because they never change, they go unnoticed.)
- 3.) We have a number of long standing service projects that help the poor. We believe the problem is that they are such long traditions, we've taken for granted that students know who we're serving. Therefore, we will take greater care in making sure students know who (poor) we are helping on our various service projects.
