Four-Year-Old Preschool (called PreK) is taught by Ms. Kathy Hansen and her assistant, Ms. Eli Chavarria. Ms. Kathy attended ISU and has more than 30 years of teaching experience in several different settings. She also has endorsements in both reading and early childhood education. PreK is held four days a week, Tuesday-Friday. Students must be four years old by September 15th of the current school year. The SFC PreK program meets lowa Quality Preschool Programming Standards, administered by the Iowa Department of Education. The Iowa Early Learning Standards are used to guide expectations for the children and instructional practices. SFC is considered a Community Partner with Marshalltown Community School District which requires four-year-old preschool students to complete registration at both SFC and MCSD. The Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program (SWVPP). SWVPP is funded through the Iowa Department of Education so there are no registration fees or tuition.
