An essential component of our client-inspired services includes education and outreach to bring critical information to communities throughout the 30 counties of the Archdiocese of Dubuque. In March, our Immigration Legal Services team hosted an immigration clinic in the Postville community for Spanish-speaking families. This clinic covered pathways to lawful status in the United States, comprehensive information on family-based immigration processes, and clarity surrounding non-citizen status and humanitarian immigration options. Families were provided free on-site consultations

with an immigration attorney and interpreter to help them determine the next steps in their immigration journey. Access to professional immigration legal services in their native language empowers families to make informed decisions as they navigate an incredibly complex immigration system. 
