Dear Parishioners,

This week, we celebrate Catholic Schools Week. We are blessed to have St. Paul's Catholic School, here in our own parish. We offer our prayers this week for all of our students, teachers, and staff, both past and present. We also thank everyone who makes sacrifices to support St. Paul's School. May God reward you for your generosity.

Pope Francis has called for a Synod on Synods, and Bishop Coyne is asking for our input. This raises an important question: What exactly is a synod? A synod is a gathering of bishops and other church leaders from around the world to discuss particular topics or issues. (These are universal synods, in contrast to smaller meetings like our diocesan synod, which was held a few years ago). The word "synod" comes from the Greek for "walk together." These meetings have usually taken place every four years since the Second Vatican Council in the 1960s, to discuss topics such as the Eucharist, the priesthood, and the family. This synod is on synods themselves.

Synods provide recommendations to the pope, but he makes final decisions. Before a synod meets, the bishops seek input from the faithful in all the dioceses around the world. That includes us. The fact that most of us, including me (I had to do some research to write this up), don't know much about synods and how they work, perhaps proves the point that we all need to learn more about this process. To help us all provide input, our diocese has provided a link to a questionnaire, available here: www.vermontcatholic.org/universalsynod We will also have a parish listening session within the next couple months to offer our thoughts.

The Sacrament of Penance (continued)
In the Communion of Saints (continued)**

1476 We also call these spiritual goods of the communion of saints the Church's treasury, which is "not the sum total of the material goods which have accumulated during the course of the centuries. On the contrary the 'treasury of the Church' is the infinite value, which can never be exhausted, which Christ's merits have before God. They were offered so that the whole of mankind could be set free from sin and attain communion with the Father. In Christ, the Redeemer himself, the satisfactions and merits of his Redemption exist and find their efficacy."
1477 "This treasury includes as well the prayers and good works of the Blessed Virgin Mary. They are truly immense, unfathomable, and even pristine in their value before God. In the treasury, too, are the prayers and good works of all the saints, all those who have followed in the footsteps of Christ the Lord and by his grace have made their lives holy and carried out the mission the Father entrusted to them. In this way they attained their own salvation and at the same time cooperated in saving their brothers in the unity of the Mystical Body."
