5-Day Directed Retreat at Saint Anne's Shrine

The Society of St. Edmund will be conducting a 5-Day Directed Retreat in the Ignatian tradition from Sunday June 11 to Friday June 16, 2023, at St. Anne's Shrine in Isle La Motte.
