Four of the Many Catholic Chaplains who have Sacrificed their Lives in Service to our Country

Servant of God,

Fr. Joseph Verbis Lafleur (1912-1944)
Lieutenant, U.S. Army Air Corps, World War II.
Died saving fellow POWs from a torpedoed ship in the Pacific.
Distinguished Service Cross, Bronze Star, & Purple Heart.



Servant of God,

Fr. Emil Joseph Kapaun (1916-1951)
Captain, U.S. Army, World War II & Korean War.
Died in a North Korean POW camp, after giving away his food to fellow imprisoned soldiers.
Medal of Honor, Legion of Merit, Bronze Star, & Purple Heart.



Servant of God,

Fr. Vincent Robert Capodanno (1929-1967)
Lieutenant, U.S. Navy Reserve, Vietnam War.
Killed in combat, administering the Last Rites and carrying away the wounded under heavy enemy fire.
Medal of Honor, Bronze Star, & Purple Heart.



Fr. Henry Timothy Vakoc (1960-2009)
Major, U.S. Army, Iraq War.
Died in 2009 from injuries sustained in a 2004 IED explosion while returning from offering Mass for soldiers near Mosul.
Bronze Star & Purple Heart.

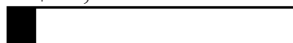
