Happy Father's Day to all the fathers in our parish! We thank you for all the ways you have guided and inspired us throughout our lives. There will be a special blessing for fathers at the end of our Masses this weekend.



It's hard to believe, but this weekend marks seven years since I was ordained as a priest. Throughout my three years as a parochial vicar (assistant priest) at Corpus Christi Parish in St. Johnsbury and my nearly four years as administrator and pastor here at Holy Trinity Parish, I have had so many opportunities to serve God and His faithful people. This service has included celebrating Mass, administering baptisms, visiting sick and elderly parishioners to bring them Holy Communion and offer the anointing of the sick, providing marriage preparation classes and officiating at weddings, counseling grieving families and offering funeral Masses, teaching religious education classes, and ministering to people facing personal difficulties and other hardships. There have been many challenging days, but also many graces and blessings. Thank you for all your prayers and support. I couldn't do what I do without you.

The priesthood is a demanding yet rewarding vocation. That is why I'm glad to see that two new young men from our Diocese, Charles Cacciatore and Samuel McCoy, have decided to join the seminary and commit themselves to discerning if God is calling them to the priesthood.
