Our parish has a subscription, so it is **completely free to you**. It offers a lot of quality Catholic education and entertainment, so be sure to check it out!

Many parishioners are also recommending the Hallow App, available on smartphones. I haven't checked it out yet myself, but many parishioners are saying they enjoy the daily prayers and meditations, the Rosary, Fr. Mike Schmitz's "Bible in a Year," and even fun Catholic trivia questions. There is a



free version and also a paid subscription with even more content (for \$9.99 per month or \$69.99 per year).

For those of us who are less technologically inclined, our parish also has the St. Anthony Library, with many great Catholic books available, located in the sacristy at the back of St. John Vianney Church in Irasburg.
