During Summer, our schedules can be a little more open. It's a great opportunity to check out some of the great Catholic resources available to help us grow in our faith.

Our parish has a subscription to Formed.org, an online resource of great Catholic movies, video series, e-books, and audiobooks. In order to access it, just go to formed.org and click on "Sign Up." Under "Create New Account," "Find Your Parish or Organization," type "Most Holy Trinity Barton." Our parish should come up at the top of the list. Click on it, then enter your name and email address, and click "Sign Up." Then you will be able to access a great catalogue of Catholic videos and other media available on Formed. If you would like help signing up, just let me know. Our parish has a subscription, so it is **completely free to you**. It offers a lot of quality Catholic education and entertainment, so be sure to check it out!



Many parishioners are also recommending the Hallow App, available on smartphones. I haven't checked it out yet myself, but many parishioners are saying they enjoy the daily prayers and meditations, the Rosary, Fr. Mike Schmitz's "Bible in a Year," and even fun Catholic trivia questions. There is a free version and also a paid subscription with even more content (for \$9.99 per month or \$69.99 per year).



For those of us who are less technologically inclined, our parish also has the St. Anthony Library, with many great Catholic books available, located in the sacristy at the back of St. John Vianney Church in Irasburg.
