Next weekend, July 22-23, the Diocese will be sponsoring a special collection to support relief for victims of the flooding in Vermont. Please be generous to this worthy cause.

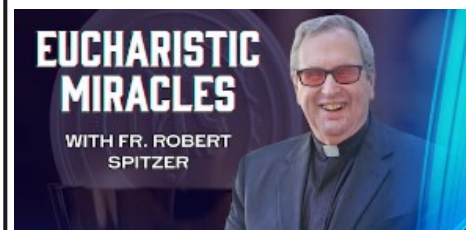
