- Bishop John Michaud (1899-1908) Burlington, VT
- 3. Bishop Joseph Rice (1910-1938) Springfield, MA
- Bishop Matthew Brady (1938-1944) Hartford, CT 4.
- Bishop Edward Ryan (1944-1956) Boston, MA 5.
- Bishop Robert Joyce (1956-1971) Burlington, VT
- Bishop John Marshall (1971-1992) Worcester, MA
- Bishop Kenneth Angell (1992-2005) Providence, RI
- Bishop Salvatore Matano (2005-2013) Providence, RI
- 10. Bishop Christopher Covne (2014-2023) Boston, MA

Our bishops have tended to come from neighboring New England dioceses. It is rare, especially nowadays, for a priest to become the bishop of his home diocese, though two Vermonters have become our bishop. A handful of other Vermonters also became bishops elsewhere:

William Tyler, 1st Bishop of Hartford, CT (1843-1849), was born in Derby, VT.

Alexander Christie, 4th Archbishop of Oregon City, OR (1899-1925), was born in Highgate, VT.

Bernard Flanagan, 1st Bishop of Norwich, CT (1953-1959), was born in Proctor, VT.

Louis Gelineau, 6th Bishop of Providence, RI (1971-1997). was born in Burlington, VT.
