Dear Parishioners,

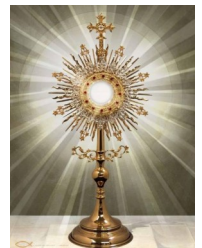

This Monday, August 21, the Church commemorates Pope St. Pius X, who served as pope from 1903 to 1914. He was a simple Italian priest, a pastor close to his parishioners, known for his piety. This was a contrast to many popes who came from noble families and served in high-ranking Church positions prior to their election as pope. As Pope, Pius instituted many pastoral initiatives, including allowing younger children to receive First Holy Communion. He was also known for his revision of the Code of Canon Law. At the end of his life, Pius worked and prayed for peace among nations in the lead up to the First World War. Let's pray that Pope St. Pius will intercede for our Church and world today.

As we await the appointment of a new bishop for our Diocese of Burlington, it might be interesting to look back on our bishops from the past 170 years. This week, let's look at the dioceses where our past bishops came from.

1. Bishop Louis DeGoesbriand (1853-1899) Troyes, France
2. Bishop John Michaud (1899-1908) Burlington, VT
3. Bishop Joseph Rice (1910-1938) Springfield, MA
4. Bishop Matthew Brady (1938-1944) Hartford, CT
5. Bishop Edward Ryan (1944-1956) Boston, MA
6. Bishop Robert Joyce (1956-1971) Burlington, VT
7. Bishop John Marshall (1971-1992) Worcester, MA
8. Bishop Kenneth Angell (1992-2005) Providence, RI
9. Bishop Salvatore Matano (2005-2013) Providence, RI
10. Bishop Christopher Coyne (2014-2023) Boston, MA

Our bishops have tended to come from neighboring New England dioceses. It is rare, especially nowadays, for a priest to become the bishop of his home diocese, though two Vermonters have become our bishop. A handful of other Vermonters also became bishops elsewhere:

William Tyler, 1st Bishop of Hartford, CT (1843-1849), was born in Derby, VT.

Alexander Christie, 4th Archbishop of Oregon City, OR (1899-1925), was born in Highgate, VT.

Bernard Flanagan, 1st Bishop of Norwich, CT (1953-1959), was born in Proctor, VT.

Louis Gelineau, 6th Bishop of Providence, RI (1971-1997), was born in Burlington, VT.

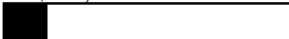
