Dear Parishioners,

This Thursday, November 9, we celebrate the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. It might seem strange to celebrate a building, instead of a saint, but there is a purpose to this celebration. The buildings where we gather as a Church community are important because they give us a place to worship God, together with other members of the Faithful. The beauty of these buildings is meant to lift our minds to God and the contemplation of holy things, as well as serve as a foretaste of what Heaven will be like. So what is special about this particular church? The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the pope's official cathedral as the Bishop of Rome. (Usually we associate the pope with St. Peter's Basilica at the Vatican, but in fact St. John Lateran is his official cathedral). When the pope defines dogmas, calls councils, or issues other official teachings, he will traditionally do it from St. John Lateran. There is no saint named "John Lateran." The basilica is dedicated to both St. John the Baptist and St. John the Apostle, and it is located on land once owned by the Lateran family during ancient Roman times.

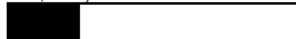
