Dear Parishioners,

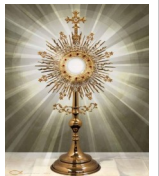

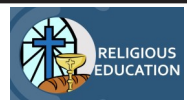

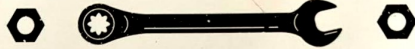
