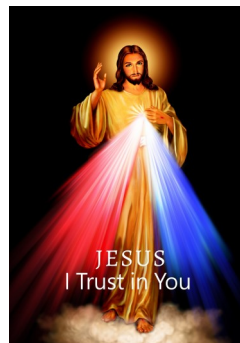
Save the Date!

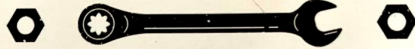
