Since this Wednesday, February 14, is Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent, I recommend celebrating St. Valentine's Day (and eating all that chocolate) the day before. Appropriately, that day is also Mardi Gras. See below for a helpful guide on Lenten fasting and abstinence.

On the Fridays of Lent, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at St. Paul's at 6 p.m.

Our Lenten Penance service is Sunday, March 10, at 3 p.m. at St. Paul's. There is also a Penance service at St. Norbert's in Hardwick on Sunday, March 17, at 3 p.m. I'll post the dates of other parish penance services when they are scheduled.

Fasting and Abstinence

When do I ...?

Fast and Abstain:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

Abstain:

All Fridays during Lent

Who has to ...?

Fast: Catholics who are 18 years of age, but not yet 59, are obliged

Abstain: observed by all Catholics 14 years-old and older

What is ...?

Fast: eating one full meal, as well as two small meals that together are not equal to a full meal

Abstinence: refrain from eating meat

Note: Persons that are exempt from fasting include: the physically or mentally ill, individuals with chronic illness, and those pregnant or nursing.

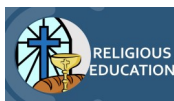

An award-winning 1994 movie from Poland.



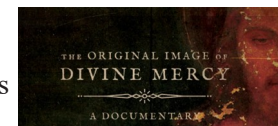
3/2/24 *Love & Mercy: Faustina*

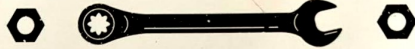
