

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is a process of study, exploration, faith-sharing, and faith formation for non-baptized adults who desire to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church and/or baptized adult Christians who desire full communion in the Catholic Church. Catholics who would like to "refresh" their knowledge of the Catholic faith are also welcome. The RCIA program in our area takes place at St. John Vianney (SJV) Parish in South Burlington.
