VIRTUAL? IN PERSON? LIVES-STREAMED?

Our campus is expanding, our facilities have different names and some events are still being held virtually or being live-streamed while others are in person.

With all these changes, the calendar on the parish website can be confusing. Here's a guide to the common terms you will see on the calendar:

- **VIRTUAL:** An event that is labeled as virtual in the title will either be live-streamed or a Zoom call. Click the event to access instructions on where to view, how to join or who to contact to participate.
- **IN-PERSON:** The only events that will have this label in the title are Masses. You may see IN-PERSON & VIRTUAL or IN-PERSON ONLY in the title.
- Events **without** VIRTUAL or IN-PERSON in the title are in-person events. Click the event to see the location on our campus where the event will take place.

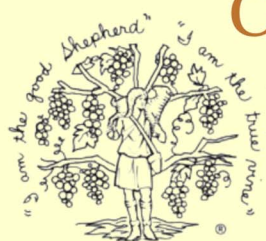

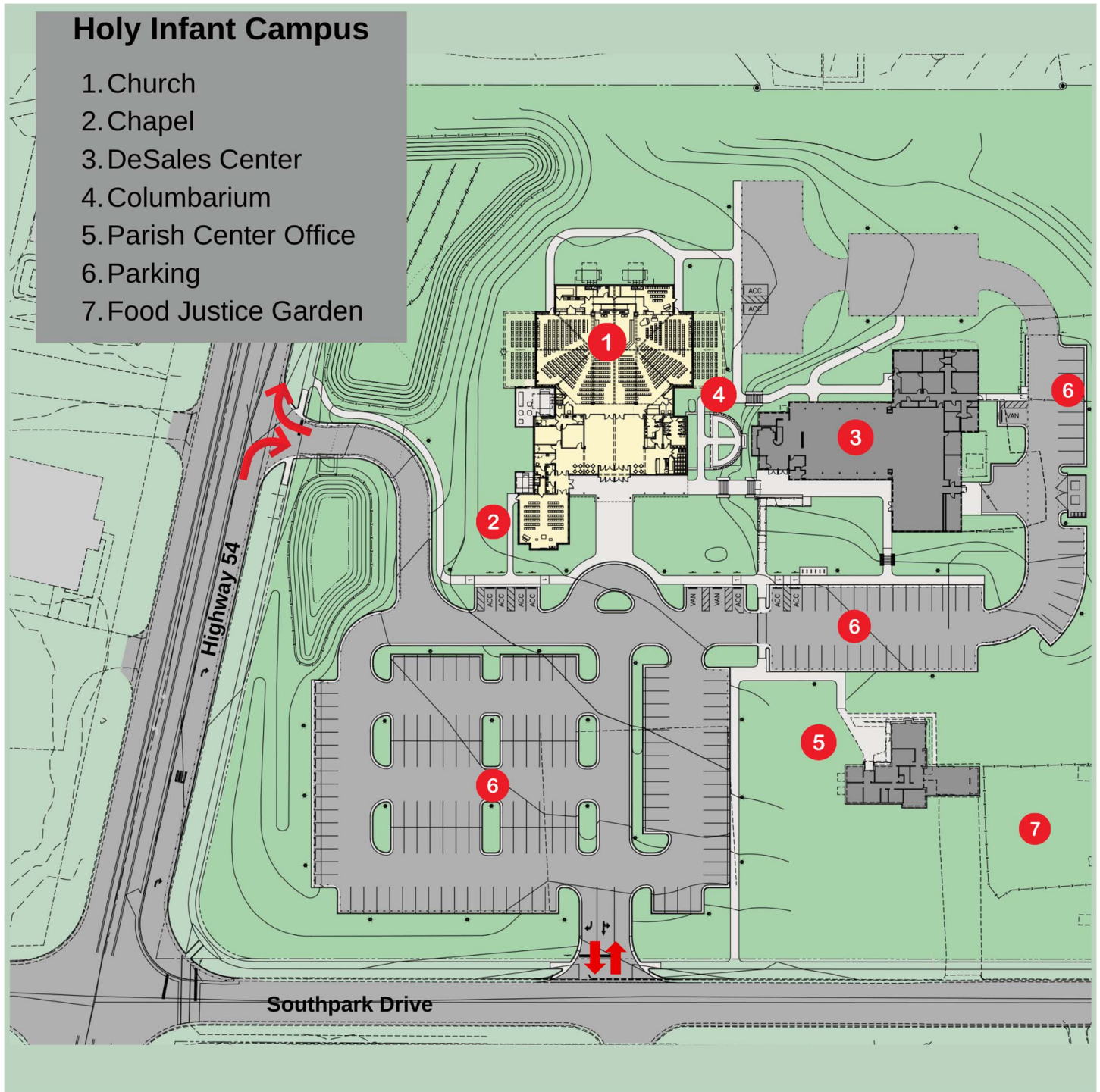

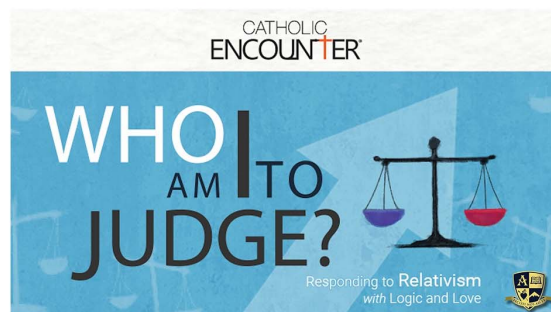
