

## FOOD JUSTICE GARDEN SEEKS LEADERS, VOLUNTEERS TO TAKE MINISTRY INTO THE FUTURE

The Food Justice Garden's total harvest to date has reached more than 4,600 pounds, surpassing last year's record-setting total of 4,569 pounds.

This would not be possible without a core group of dedicated volunteers who began this endeavor nearly a decade ago. Since record-keeping began in 2013, the garden has produced literally tons of fresh vegetables, berries, greens and herbs to local food banks and pantries – nearly 25,000 pounds.

Experimenting with planting methods and varieties of seeds as well as the addition of a bee hive in 2020 has produced impressive results, but ministry leaders say the biggest factor in their success is having many hands to assist in planting, watering, harvesting and maintaining the garden space.

Going into the next decade, the Food Justice Garden needs new volunteers and leaders who bring the ministry into the future and eventually replace our aging gardeners. Those currently driving this ministry are in their mid to late 70s.


So who is a good fit for this ministry? Anyone who enjoys being outdoors, really. Families, individuals, groups within other ministries, those with time off during the week, homeschooled young people, teens and tweens – all are welcome in the garden.

Leading the garden into the future is a particularly good fit for retired people. Most retirees moving into the area are moving into townhouses with no land of their own to dig in.

In particular, the garden is a family friendly place. Families are always welcome along with their children. Children are eager workers and can be fascinated as they learn and watch how their food grows. Organizers suggest spending at least one Saturday morning a month growing as a family in this vital ministry.

Come out and join us on any of our workdays, Tuesdays and Saturdays, beginning at 9 a.m. As we head into winter, we will be skipping bad weather days. To learn more, contact Bobi Gallagher at bobi.gallagher@gmail.com.

Jesus Christ, Redeemer of all humankind, open our hearts to encounter all young people, to accompany and be in community together, and as one Church, embark upon our holy mission.


