



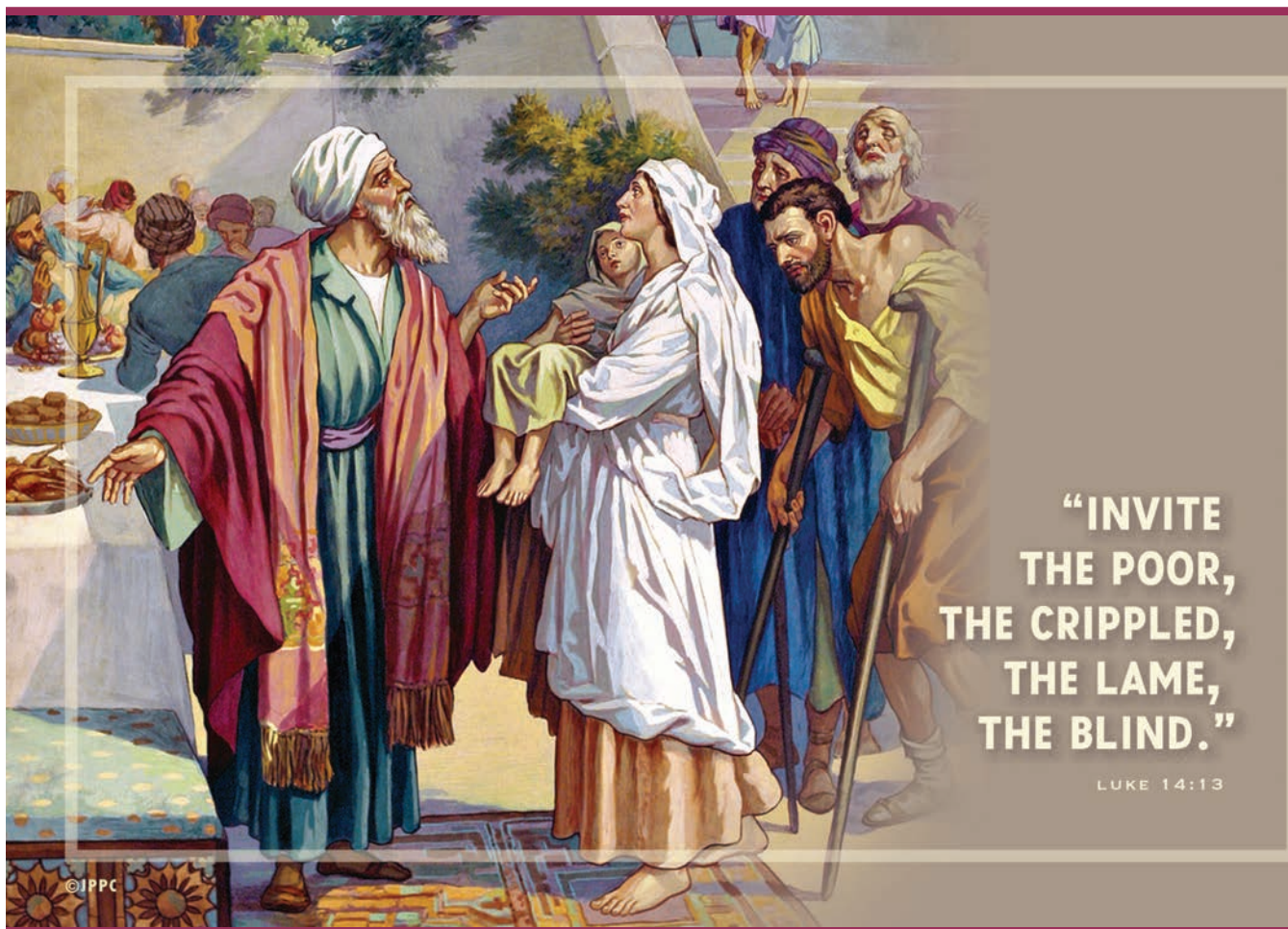

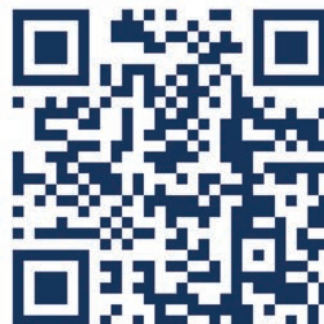

BEWARE OF SCAM EMAILS

We are aware of fake emails being sent using a bogus email address claiming to be from Father Robert. Recent scam emails purport to be from Father Robert and ask the receiver for assistance with a task. **Please help us put a stop to these emails by forwarding suspicious emails to spam@uce.gov.**

INFORMATION SESSION IS THIS WEEK!

Faith & Immigration Justice is an eight-session program in which small groups learn about immigration today and discern how they are called to respond. Elizabeth Tolman and Jan Eichen will be co-facilitators for this exploration of immigration and the Christian faith.

Through new learning from articles, videos, and books (*Welcoming the Stranger* by Jenny Hwang and Matthew Soerens and *The Line Becomes a River* by Francisco Cantú), it lends new insights to participants' understanding of immigration policy and those affected by it. By encouraging new spiritual practices and informed action, it cultivates an expanding community of Christians who work for immigration justice in their respective contexts.
