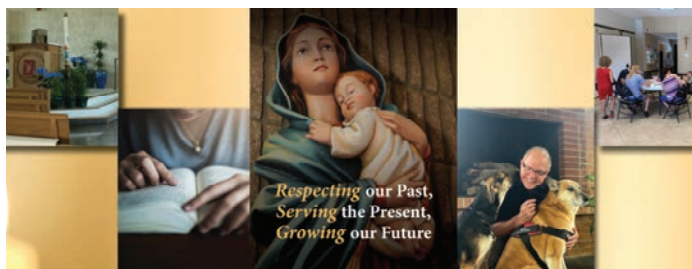

RESPECT LIFE MONTH OCTOBER 2022

Each October the Catholic Church in the United States celebrates Respect Life Month, and the first Sunday of October is observed as Respect Life Sunday. As Catholics, we are called to cherish, defend and protect those who are most vulnerable, from the beginning of life to its end, and at every point in between. During the month of October, the Church asks us to reflect more deeply on the dignity of every human life. The USCCB's theme this year is: **"Called To Serve Moms in Need."**

Parishioners are invited to participate in service to help support the ministries of Pregnancy Support Services, Room at the Inn (a maternity home for homeless women and their children) and Catholic Charities in our area. Each ministry is listed below with specific needs to support moms and children. Parishioners may purchase NEW items on one of the lists below. Gift cards will be used by the ministries for clients to purchase food, baby items and women's health care products. Please staple the receipt to the gift card. **The purchased items will be brought back, UN-WRAPPED, to the mass you attend on Respect Life Weekend, October 1 and 2.**

If you are not able to bring your gift on Respect Life Weekend, it can be dropped off at the parish center during the week at the normal office hours.

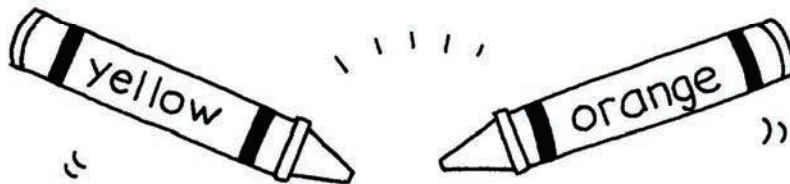
