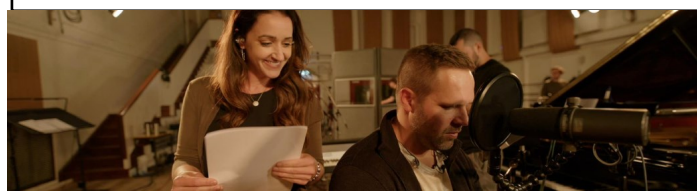

If we work together, we can end world hunger. Join us with your steps and your donations.

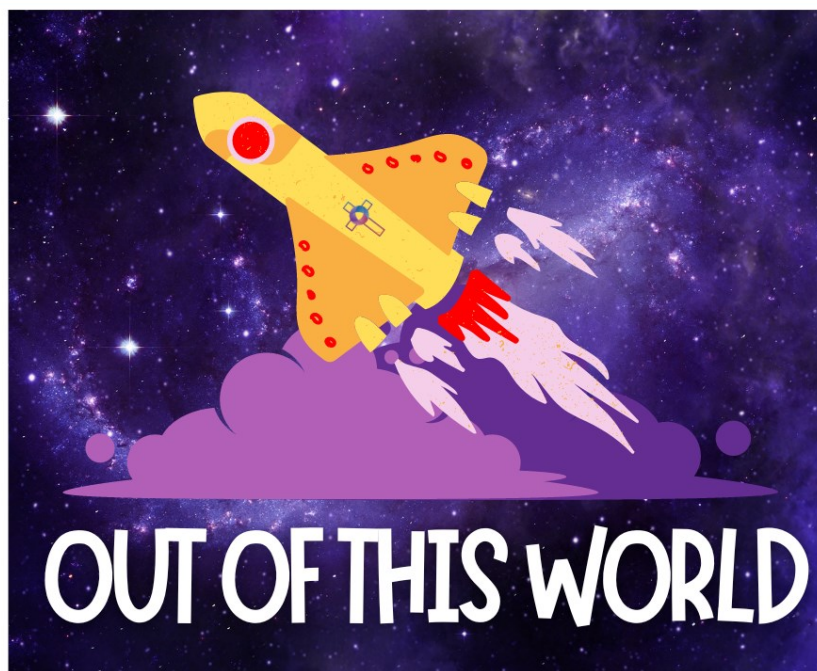

## NEIGHBOR TO NEIGHBOR

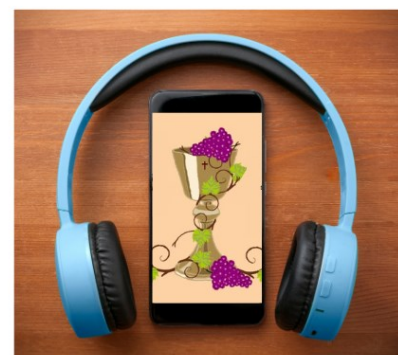
Neighbor to Neighbor started as the answer to a simple question, "How can we be good neighbors?" We found that many families in Durham did not have furniture in their homes, not even a bed to sleep in.

Neighbor to Neighbor is an outreach project that includes picking up and receiving donations of furniture and household items and then distributing them to families and individuals in need. We deliver to all the Durham Housing Authority communities, as well as families who are moving from shelters to homes, and those referred to us. A new initiative is furnishing homes for refugees sponsored by Church World Service.

- Donating items - items should be gently used and fully functional.



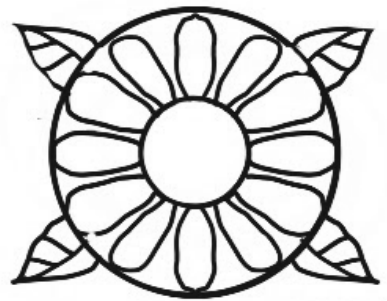
## THIS WEEK'S PODCAST EPISODE
