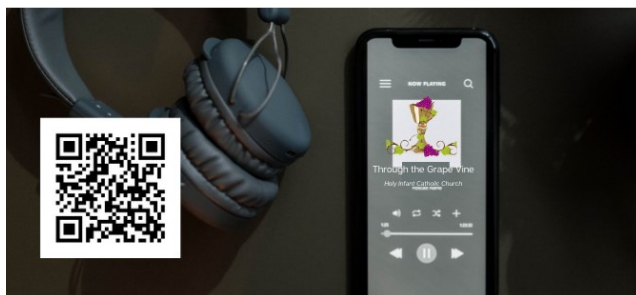

SEEKING A HOME FOR REFUGEES IN DURHAM

Holy Infant is partnering with Church World Services to find safe housing for a refugee family relocating to the Durham area. The first step in this process is finding a rental home for our future family.

We are asking parishioners to please share any leads they may know with our resettlement team. Below you'll find a list of requirements for the property.

- \$700-\$900 a month for a 1 BR
- \$900-\$1200 a month for a 2 BR
- \$1100-\$1600 a month for a 3 BR
- 3 BR apartments and houses tend to be the most versatile for our clients, as they can accommodate a wide range of

family sizes.

- Ideally, apartment complexes/homes will be located near or on a public transportation line, and there should be access to groceries within a reasonable distance.
- The clients will sign their own leases. CWS DOES NOT expect or require community sponsorship groups to co-sign leases for clients.
