The area will be surrounded with beautiful native wetland plants that will enhance the beauty of our campus and protect our environment. A preconstruction meeting to discuss the wetland pond was held on January 22.

- Tree trunks were cut to length and taken to a sawmill for use as lumber and other wood products.
- Asphalt and concrete is being recycled to avoid the cost and waste of sending to a landfill.
- · Soil removed during grading will be piled behind our current building for re-use.
