LETTER FROM THE PARISH

Each week as we continue on our Easter journey the scripture readings reveal more of the struggles the disciples had, trying to make sense of Christ's Passion, death and Resurrection.

SHRINE AND SHINE CATHOLIC MOMS' SERIES

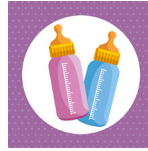

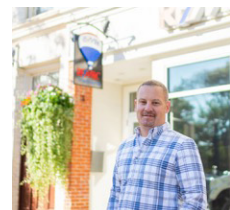
