

#### MESSAGE FROM OUR ADMINISTRATOR

Dear Parish Family,

Happy Second Sunday of Advent! Last week I asked our parish families to do some light 'penance' work to prepare our hearts for Christmas, so I hope your Advent penance is off to a good start. If not, there's time to devote ourselves to some small work of prayer, sacrifice, or service to "make straight the way of the Lord" as we bring all those areas of our life into alignment with God's plan.

Keep in mind that "preparing the way of the Lord" this Advent puts us in touch with the specificity of the Incarnation: God comes to *this people* at *this time* and in *this place* through His Son. May the specificity of God's plan for your life help you overcome all the generalizations of our times. Phrases like "I want to be a better person" or "I want to make the world a better place" are vague and don't really lead to lasting commitment or conversion. They also leave out Jesus, which is never the Christian way! Instead of these, add the holiday spice of specificity into your desires, prayers, and service: "I want to be a saint today!" and "I will serve my family with the heart of Christ!"

#### THE JESSE TREE

As part of our Advent celebration, a Jesse Tree is located in the gathering space of our church. The Jesse Tree is an artistic depiction of the ancestors of Jesus. It is a very old Christmas Tradition that first started in medieval times. The Jesse Tree takes its name from Jesse, the father of King David, from whose house the lineage of Jesus can be traced. It is a way to

pictorially tell the story of God's actions in the Old Testament. It connects the Advent season with the faithfulness of God in sending us His only Son. Through a series of Scripture readings, we trace the family tree of Jesus from Genesis to the Nativity. The symbols and their corresponding Scripture references are listed here. Reading the Scripture passage relating to each symbol is a wonderful way to prepare the whole family for the coming of lesus.

# PRAYER FOR THE SYNOD ON SYNODALITY

Every session of the Second Vatican Council began with the prayer *Adsumus Sancte Spiritus*, the first word of the Latin original

meaning, "We stand before You, Holy Spirit," which has been historically used at Councils, Synods, and other Church gatherings for hundreds of years, being attributed to Saint Isidore of Seville (c. 560-4 April 636). As we are called to embrace this synodal path of the Synod 2021-2023, this prayer invites the Holy Spirit to operate within us so that we may be a community and a people of grace. For the Synod 2021-2023, we propose to use this simplified version, so that any group or liturgical assembly can pray more easily.

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.

With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it.

We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder.

Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.

Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.
