She was with our school community for 35 years. We all benefited from her supportive spirit and generous nature. Even the parents of some of our current students remember having Coach when they were in school at St. Mary's! As a parish family, we offer our heartfelt prayers for Coach Von Lindern, for her family and friends, for her current and former students, and for all individuals and families whose lives Coach impacted. Her Funeral Mass will be at St. Mary Parish on Thursday, May 18th at 10:00 a.m.. The Mass will be livestreamed for those out of town or unable to come in person.

REFLECTION FROM SACRED HEART COUNSELING

For this same reason, a date night can happen at home with a pot of mac and cheese! It is easy to think that we fully know someone and we stop asking questions like, "What do you want to accomplish in this upcoming year?" or "When have you been the happiest in the last week?" While I love talking about the Browns on occasion, we need to engage in intentional conversations about what is going on in the hearts of the people closest to us. This week, consider having a few intentional conversations with your loved ones with the goal of learning more about the deeper areas of their heart!

- Keeping the Faith is the Diocese of Cleveland's strategic planning process to promote and ensure the future vitality of Catholic elementary schools in the diocese.
- The vision of Keeping the Faith includes every parish in the diocese collaborating in tangible ways to support a Catholic elementary school or schools in the parish vicinity.
- Locally, the pastors, principals and business managers, from Lake and Geauga counties are working together to pilot creating a local plan to embrace the vision of Keeping the Faith, that includes every parish in the two counties formally associating with a school with their time, talent, and/or treasure and ensuring the schools are strong a viable by collaborating with each other, sharing resources and leveraging talent.
- We are partnering with the Meitler Consultants, a national Catholic consulting firm, to help guide and implement this collaborative planning process.
- We are now gathering and analyzing data in all areas of the strategic plan and will use this to lead us in visioning a strong and exciting plan.

HELP PROTECT THE DIGNITY OF LIFE

Life in its earliest and most vulnerable stages is threatened by groups proposing an amendment to the Ohio Constitution for the November 2023 ballot to expand and enshrine abortion at the expense of protections for preborn children and women. The Catechism of the Catholic Church proclaims that "human life

must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception." The Church accompanies and supports women facing unexpected pregnancies and mothers through programs like Walking with Moms in Need and the services of Catholic Charities. The bishops of Ohio strongly encourage Catholics statewide to unite in prayer and work to defeat this proposed amendment and its grave consequences for women and preborn children in Ohio. SUMMER LUNCH PROGRAM

Did you know that 1 out of every 3 children in the Cardinal School District qualify for free or reduced lunch during the school year? The number is 1 in 5 in the Berkshire and Chardon School District and 1 in 10 in the West Geauga School District. In 2019, Claridon Community Helps began the "Now That's What I'm Talking About!" Summer Lunch program to feed children during the summer months. Since that time, we have provided 36,737 lunches to children in 12 townships within 4 school districts.

Volunteers are needed to prepare and serve lunch to children this summer. Volunteers of all ages are welcome! You can join us for a day, a week or the whole summer. We prepare lunches at Claridon Congregational Church every Monday, Wednesday and Friday beginning **Friday, May 26th and continue through Monday, August 14th** (We do not serve meals on Memorial Day.) 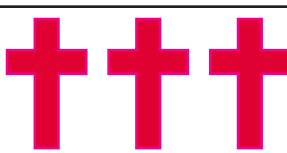

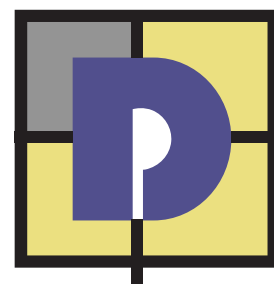
