ANGEL SCHOLARSHIP FUND: IMPORTANT TAX INFORMATION

The Angel Scholarship Fund (ASF) is a State of Ohio approved Scholarship Granting Organization. Donors to ASF may be eligible for a 100% tax credit on their State of Ohio income tax return for the year the contribution is made. The maximum credit amount is \$750.00 per individual; married couples that file a joint return can each claim this credit if both spouses make eligible donations (\$1,500.00 total).

2023 was a tremendous success! Many thanks to all who designated their ASF contribution to St. Mary School in 2023! We received a total of \$196,330.00, which will provide tuition assistance for our students in the 2024/2025 school year. There is still time to increase our total when you contribute before April 15 and claim the tax credit for 2023.

2023 ASF Donors – Please Note: ASF Tax Receipts have been sent to ASF donors to submit with the state tax form. Donations to ASF are nonrefundable credits; and the total of your nonrefundable credits cannot exceed the amount of your state tax liability. Ohio nonrefundable credits are entered on line 9 of the Ohio IT 1040.*: *This does not constitute legal or tax advice. ASF donors should contact a tax preparer with questions associated with payments to ASF.*

IT'S NOT TOO LATE TO DONATE AND CLAIM A 2023 TAX CREDIT!

SACRED HEART COUNSELING REFLECTION

In my line of work, I often hear people say that they should be happy. "I have food and shelter, while there are hungry kids in the world. I have everything I need. I am anxious and depressed, while I should be grateful and happy." While we pray for and help those less fortunate, it does not mean that our suffering is irrelevant or painless. We will all experience suffering, pain, and hardship in this life. Gratitude is a great discipline to practice, but we sometimes take it too far and use it as a reason to dismiss our pain and suffering. We are also guilty at times of exaggerating our suffering or letting it excuse vice and selfishness. That being said, we also need to acknowledge and care for the suffering that we experience. Sometimes, that acknowledgement and care comes by managing our road rage and remaining civil or sacrificing our favorite restaurant for our spouse's favorite. Some suffering can be acknowledged, sacrificed easily, and moved on from. However, there are times that we are carrying heavy burdens or struggling with mental illness that needs more intensive care and attention. This care can come in many forms such as support groups, intentional conversations with friends, counseling, or talking with a priest. Gratitude can keep us humble, content, and focused on God, but it is often not enough for problems like complex trauma in our past, difficulties in our relationships, depression, or anxiety. If these words resonate with you, consider giving more care and attention to your suffering and finding the potential relief and healing that you need.
