### V. Highlighted Ministry – Faith Formation - Bonnie Spurr

- Overall numbers have declined since Covid this year is down compared to last year
- Faith Formation classes are Sunday and Monday appears sports/other activities are taking precedent
- Some brainstorming took place on next steps to better understand the trend
  - Debra Sullivan Confirmation 1 & 2:
  - Recommended class length and course length be reduced
  - Incorporate service into the class time

  - September 25, 2022, start mass attendance has improved 195 attendees vs. the previous three weeks which does include Faith Formation
  - The school has been active targeting messages student families
  - o The same for those receiving sacraments
  - Mass attendance has reached 1,395 an increase of 231
