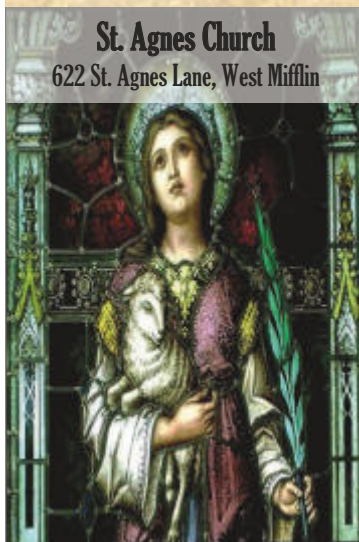

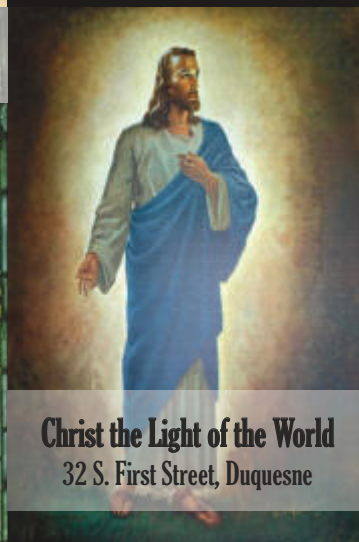

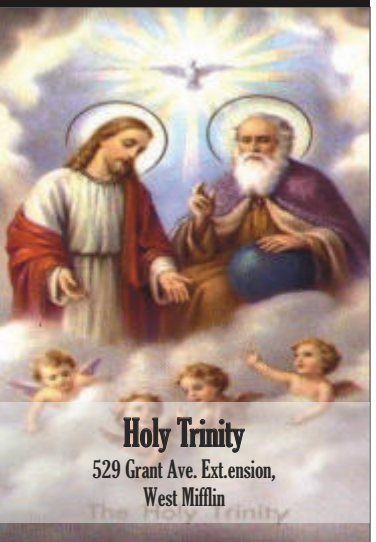

The submission should list the name that you are suggesting, the reason, your name and signature and the parish where you are registered. 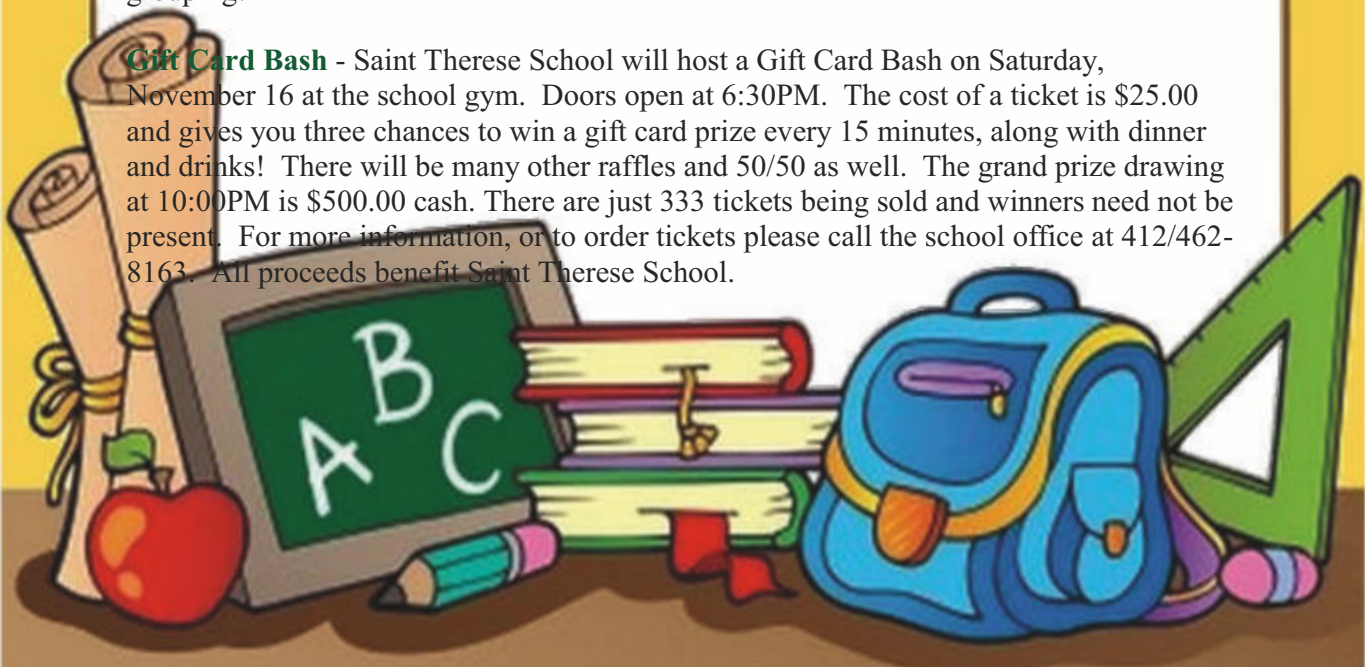
