




NAMING OUR PARISH - A reminder that any registered parishioner who would like to submit a name suggestion for our new parish should do so by November 10th. Any proposed name should be taken from the Most Holy Trinity; Our Lord Jesus Christ, invoked under a mystery of his life or under his name as used in the liturgy or Scripture; the Holy Spirit; the Blessed Virgin Mary under a given title already found in the liturgy; the holy angels: a saint from the list found in the Church's calendar of memorials and feasts; all names of those who are beatified or named "blessed". It is preferable to not choose a name that is already used many times in the diocese. Hyphenated names of current parishes are not permitted. The submission should list the name that you are suggesting, the reason, your name and signature and the parish where you are registered. All submissions can be placed in the collection basket or dropped off at the parish offices. Please see a member of council or staff if you have any questions.
