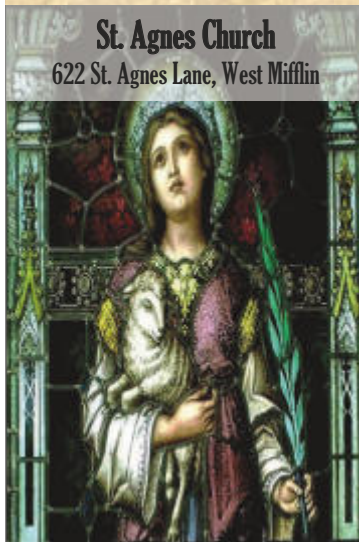

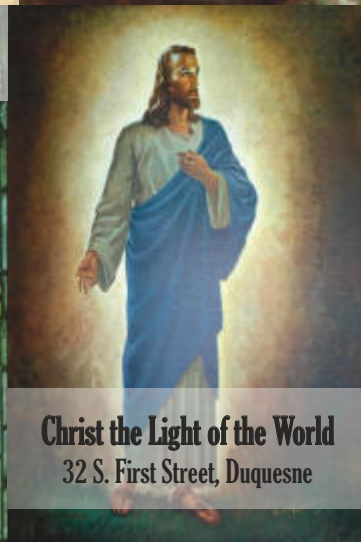

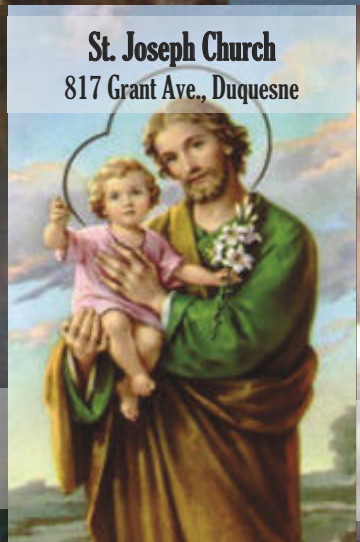

A special note of thanks to Mary Ann Venturella, who served as the bookkeeper at St. Rita and Resurrection Parishes, to Debbie Stewart who served as the bookkeeper at CLW and St. Joseph, to Terry Fuller who was secretary at CLW and St. Joseph, to Joseph Madar who cleaned CLW and opened the church, to Debra Lesko who washed the purificators, and to Ray Judy who was our cantor. Thank you to Len Potemra and Melanie Kirchartz, the organists at Holy Trinity and St. Agnes. Thank you to Bill Jakub who worked at Holy Trinity and to Donna Lew-Buechel, who will stay on until the end of April as our CCD Coordinator. You fine people have served the church well. Some of you for many years, others for a short amount of time. Some of these folks chose not to re-apply, and others unfortunately were displaced due to the necessity of downsizing.

Effective Monday, February 3rd, our new parish configuration will be as follows:

Father Dan will remain at St. Max. This will be the central office. Trish DiGiannunzio will be the Central Office Coordinator. Her duties will include: scheduling all funerals, bulletin preparation, all hall rentals, scheduling Masses for St. Max, St. Rita and Resurrection. The three Mass intention books will be located at St. Max. Trish will also be responsible for overseeing ticket ordering and fundraising events, ordering all wine, hosts and candles and anything else needed sacramentally, and ordering office supplies. She will serve as Father Dan's private secretary for all correspondence sent out from the parish. All calls going into Resurrection and St. Rita will be re-directed to St. Max. You can still use the same numbers of Resurrection and St. Rita. The Administration Center at Resurrection will be closed.

The office at Holy Trinity will be closed. Suzann Bevan will be relocated to Christ the Light of the World. All calls for St. Agnes and Holy Trinity will be re-directed to CLW. All Masses to be scheduled for CLW, Holy Trinity, St. Agnes and St. Joseph will go through this office.

The office at St. Therese will remain open. Cindi Picciafoco will be the parish secretary. All baptisms and marriages will go through this office. Cindi will continue to maintain the Mass book at St. Therese. Cindi will also be responsible for posting all contributions and parish share information.

Ray Fonos will be the business manager. He will coordinate the banking and all financial matters for our eight separate parishes until July of 2020, when we become one new parish. He will continue to oversee the school and cafeteria bills along with the Food Pantry. Fran Magnuson will work out of St. Therese on a part-time basis to file and send out all bills and checks.

Lori Ellis will continue to work out of St. Therese, overseeing the CCD, Youth Ministry, Bereavement Ministry, Sacramental Preparation and Adult Catechesis.

The Music Ministry Office will be located at St. Therese. Tom Coyne will be the director of music. Nina Mascio will be the full-time musician. Debbie Walters and Greg Lesko will be part-time musicians.

The Maintenance Staff office will be located at St. Max. Rick Booker will oversee all 32 buildings and deal with whatever may arise. Jason Bevan will work with him full-time. Tom Dougherty will continue part-time to take care of St. Joseph and CLW churches and hall. Leona Bickus will continue to clean Resurrection Church part-time. Maggie Bevan will continue to clean St. Agnes and now Holy Trinity part-time. Eric Fantaske will continue to maintain St. Therese Church. Aidan DiGiannunzio will continue to take care of St. Max. Arlene will cook dinner on Monday and Thursday. Robin Segina will continue to clean the offices at St. Therese as well as Fr. Emmanuel and Father Nick's living space as well as doing the laundry.

Jon Cuniak will continue his role as the principal of St. Therese School. Sister Cynthia will continue her role in St. Therese School along with being the Safe Environment Coordinator for our entire grouping.

As you can see, this is still a huge undertaking, but by working together, we can and will take care of all the spiritual and temporal needs of our people. Please be patient.

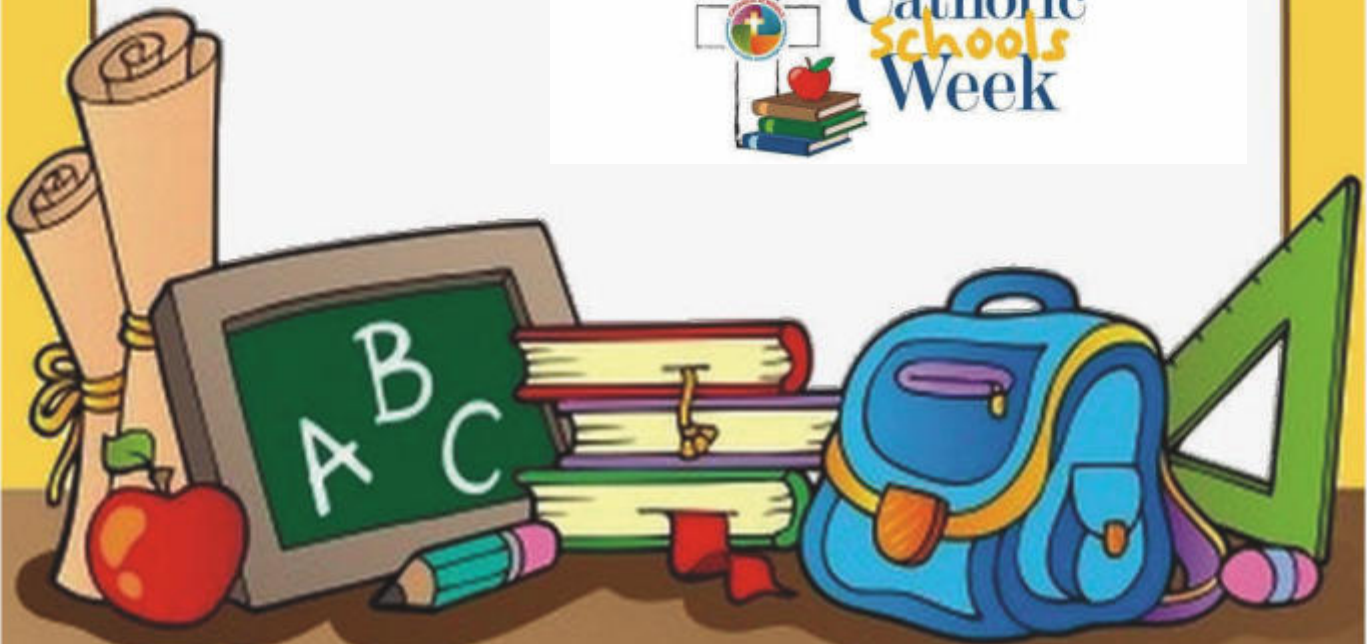
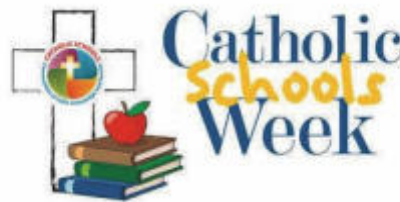
This week at Saint Therese School...

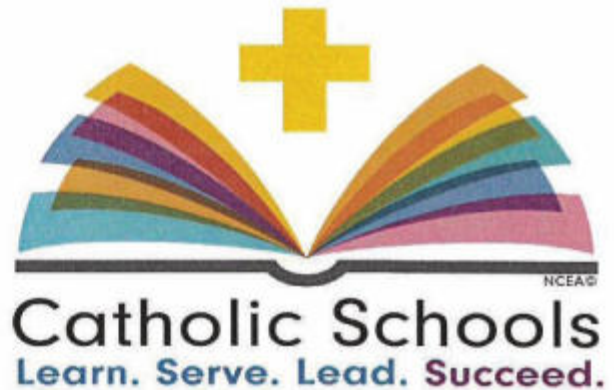
