

Dear Parishioners,

This past Thursday, December 8, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Tomorrow, December 12, we observe the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. On this feast we remember that in December, 1531 Mary appeared to a native Mexican looking like a native Mexican woman. These apparitions took place only a few years after the Spanish conquest of most of South and Central America. The fact that Mary appeared to a native man as a native woman conveyed the very important message that God's love included all people of every race and nation. These apparitions played a huge role in the conversion of much of the native population of Latin America to the Catholic Faith. We can think of the Immaculate Conception as being primarily concerned with Mary as disciple of Jesus Christ and Our Lady of Guadalupe as focusing on her role as evangelizer. May we imitate Mary as hearing the good news and also as sharers of that message.

Council 9400 tidbit - Why "Jesus"? Jesus' name in Hebrew is Yehoshua (Yeh-HO-shoo-ah), "the Lord is salvation." The Greek transliteration is 'lesous', which was transliterated into Latin as lesus. It later became the English name, Jesus. "Christ" is a Greek title translated from the word christos, derived from the Hebrew Messiah, meaning "anointed". Only after his Resurrection did the title gradually become the proper name, Jesus Christ or Christ Jesus.
