On Thursday, February 2, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. On this Feast we remember Joseph and Mary bringing the 40 day old Jesus to the temple to be presented to God. On this occasion we are especially reminded that Christ is the light of the world. All the candles we use in the church remind us of Christ the light. The Presentation is sometimes referred to as Candlemas Day. Masses that day will begin with a ceremony involving candles near the entrance of the church. Anyone wanting to have candles blessed may bring them to the entrance of the church and place them on the table which will be there. Also, Friday, February 3 is the Memorial of St. Blaise. The blessing of throats will be given in place of the Final Blessing at Masses that day. May we always walk in the light of Christ.
