**A NOTE FROM THE BISHOP

On March 20, 2023 I met with the priests of the diocese and Uniting in Heart leadership team at the Saint Joseph Retreat & Conference Center. Proposals to our diocesan pastoral plan were shared based on the consultation that has been ongoing since January. The motivation of our consultations has been to respect the capacities of our priests, and to better enable them to shepherd God's people.

A Holy Hour was intentionally included in the agenda to allow everyone an opportunity to pray through the proposals and then share thoughts after lunch. Some good interventions were made and they will be looked at and discerned further. However, we have moved beyond the consultation phase of this process and we are now making final plans for implementation.
