IN THE DEACON'S CORNER





Have you ever "experienced" the mountaintop? Several years back, Sherie and I visited our daughter and her family when they lived just outside Colorado Springs, in the very shadow of Pike's Peak. While there, we did the "tourist" thing, and rode the cog-train to the top of that mountain [we literally had a mountaintop experience]. The view was spectacular, the temperature was cold [the "wind chill" made it feel like 12 below zero], and the experience was more than a little exhilarating!

Our mountaintop experience was WAY different from that of Peter, James, and John. Jesus invited these three apostles to accompany Him to the mountaintop to give them a glimpse of His Heavenly glory – of His Divine Nature. His disciples were able to see with their own eyes what He would "become", and of what they (and

each of us) could become. In sharing that moment of encounter, we all can catch a glimpse of what potentially awaits each of us for all eternity.

For many of us, mountaintop experiences like that are few and far between. We have them, but they all too quickly diminish or become diluted when we're forced to climb back down the mountain and live in the "real" world, with all of its problems and worries; its bills and complications. BUT WE DO HAVE THEM! In the Cursillo movement, those encounters are known as "God moments". And when we do experience a profound encounter with Christ, we not only delight in the moment, we need to savor the experience, like the taste of a fine wine, or the beauty of a magnificent sunset. More importantly, we need to share those moments [those experiences] with others. Hopefully, IN that moment, we experience an encounter that will profoundly change us forever [as most encounters with Christ generally do]. And with an equal exuberance, we hopefully have the courage to share that experience our experience of Jesus with others.


