

Liturgy of the Hours

When I first moved up here to St. Isidore Pastorate, in one of my first bulletin articles, I invited questions from the congregation about most any subject. Well, I finally received the following from one of our brothers/sisters [you know who you are] in the pews:

Hey Deacon, you mentioned in one of your homilies the "Liturgy of the Hours" what is that?

Great question – and thanks for asking! The Liturgy of the Hours [LOH] is the "official" prayer of the Church. Its purpose is to sanctify [to make holy] ALL the hours of the day in God. As such, there are set hours when specific groups of prayer are offered – Morning, Daytime, Evening, Night, and the Office of Readings. These prayers are divided into a four-week cycle, and are structured to augment the Church's liturgical seasons, feasts, etc. My Formation Director once said that the prayers in LOH are "both a preparation for Mass as well as an extension of it."

The Sacred Liturgy [the Mass] is of course the highest form of prayer in our Church – the Liturgy of the Hours is set up in such a way as to compliment and extend the prayers of the Mass throughout the day, allowing us to follow Jesus' command to "pray always" [Luke 18:1]. For its being the official prayer of the Church, I find it amazing how few people know about or have even heard of the LOH. Sadly, I was one that fell into this category. I was first introduced to the LOH during my formation to the diaconate, and it has been a part of my daily routine ever since. I recall hearing some time ago that one of the reasons why so many people leave the Church and are drawn to the Muslim faith is because Muslims stop what they're doing several times per day to pray to Allah.

It's important to note that praying the LOH is never considered a "private devotion" even if it is prayed alone. It is, as I mentioned earlier, the prayer of the Church, and is therefore offered [celebrated] as a community with others around the world who are also praying these same prayers for the Church, for the remission of sin, for the forgotten souls in Purgatory, etc. As Clergy, and as a part of the Ordination Rite, I have made a promise to pray this prayer daily, but the LOH is NOT LIMITED to the Clergy alone – it is a prayer that EVERYONE can [and should] pray. Learning to do so can be a little intimidating at first, but with the help of modern technology, even the daunting task of navigation the Breviary has diminished. If you're interested in learning more about the Liturgy of the Hours, please stop me after Mass sometime and let's chat.



Day 1 - the children learned from the story of Jonah that God is everywhere and we cannot hide from Him. They had a great time being swallowed by our "whale."

Day 2 – we learned that storms come into our lives but we have Jesus in our "boats" and should not be afraid.

Day 3 – it was a story of soldiers and captives (including St. Paul) in the midst of a storm. Paul's faith and courage never wavered and he taught his captors about Jesus whom we need to trust.

Day 4 – the children learned that each one of us is treasured by God. We all have unique gifts and talents to share with others so to store up "treasure" in heaven.

Day 5 – We read the description of our treasured heaven – gold and jewels – and then the children enacted the story of the suffering vs. the rewarded in after-life. Learning that it is through caring and sharing of ourselves, our gifts and treasures, that we become saints.

We averaged 52 students per day, 10 adults, and 10 teen helpers. It was the adventure of a lifetime! As for next year, many of the children want to go on a SAFARI...get ready...It's a jungle out there.



Embark on a month-long journey into some of the great mysteries of our Church.


